POLISH PARENTS' EVALUATION OF THE MOBILITIES TO Brno, Chekia AND Marmolejo, Spain

- We interviewed 10 parents asking them 8 questions
- Generally, Polish parents found both mobilities successful and satisfying.

CONCLUSIONS:

1. Information, organization of the mobilities and the contact with accompanying teachers were rated as good or very good.
2. In both mobilities most parents believe that the hosting families did their best to cater for their children's needs. There was only one case of hosting problems reported during the mobilities, but it was directly and effectively settled by the Czech team. Parents expressed their personal gratitude to the teachers for handling the situation so well.
3. All the parents questioned answered that the thematics, the scope of interest and the activities of the project were relevant and very important. Parents consider both visits as the great educational opportunity for their children.
4. Most parents declared that they are trying to spread the information about the mobility and the project in their local communities.
5. All the parents believe their child benefited from the mobility and they stated that it was a chance of cultural and educational exchange/improvement of language skills/ gaining more self-confidence, independence and new perspectives/realizing some universal problems all the Europeans have to face/ making new friends/ visiting places of interest,/being able to travel abroad/discovering new interests, broadening the awareness of European and global issues.

Feedback from Crisis Intervention Centre on our visit and the act of solidarity in Gdynia

- **The employees of the centre were really impressed by the fact that IWE team is dealing with such difficult and complex matters.**

Summary of the answers:

1) Presumptions

83 % of the students had previous experiences from travelling abroad/outside Scandinavia, whereas 17 % had never travelled abroad before, so the parents were excited and pleased to be able to have their child participating in a funded international project like this. All respondents (100%) were pleased and certified that the information given about the mobility had been adequate and extensive, as well as all travelling information (itinerary, accommodation/hosting family, program, travel tips) was carefully and adequately given, well in advance.

67% of the parents had participated in an equal opportunity to travel abroad in their youth.

67% of the travelling students had shown relative or great excitement before the mobility. Relative excitement level was explained further by referring to the hectic schedule in school with many overlapping events and activities at the time prior to the mobility. According to the parents, some students had been nervous and anxious about spending a week in a foreign family.

2) Experiences after the mobility

According to the open responses, all the parents informed that their child had been extremely pleased and happy after the mobility (both Czech and Spain). Some had even wanted to stay longer in the country. The hosting families both in Czech and Spain had been very friendly and hospitable.

The programs of the mobilities were highly praised.

Also, many long-lasting friendships were created and the parents praised the opportunity that was given to use a foreign language, make new friends and learn about the self. Additionally, the cultural experiences were highly appreciated.

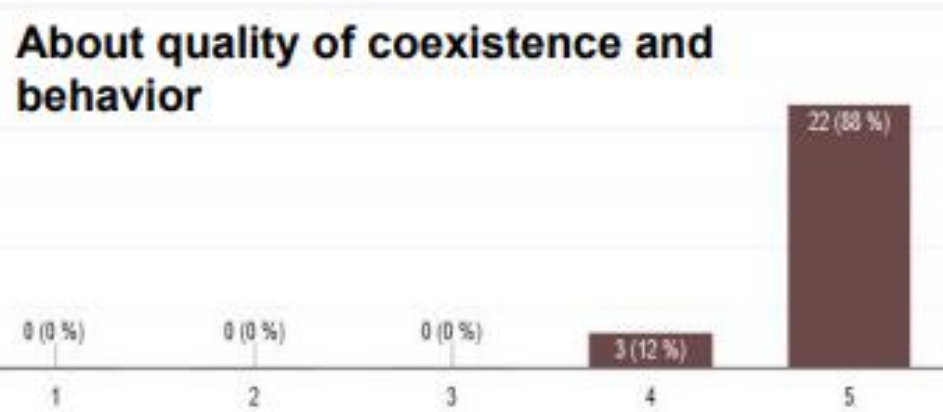
Informing of the mobility process, pictures and reports on IWE-Kannas high school Facebook page were very appreciated and made the trip visible for the parents.

Overall, according to the parents, the mobility experiences had been highly valuable and they would recommend this experience to their other children as well.

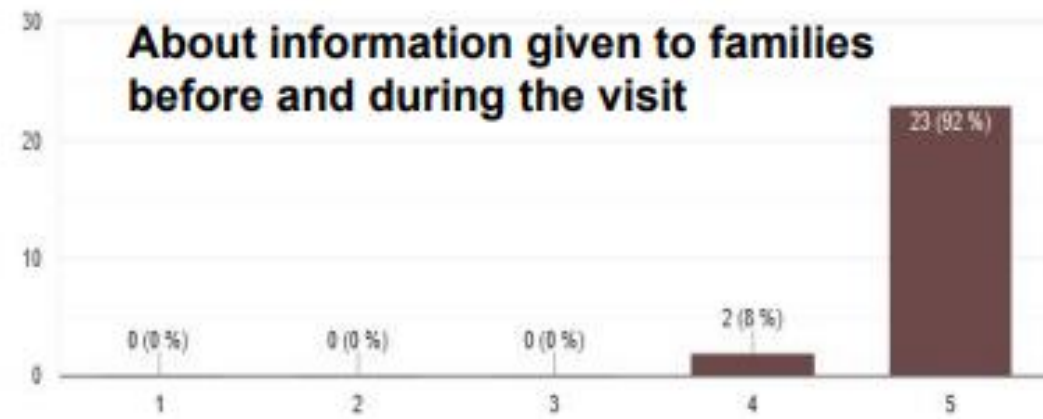

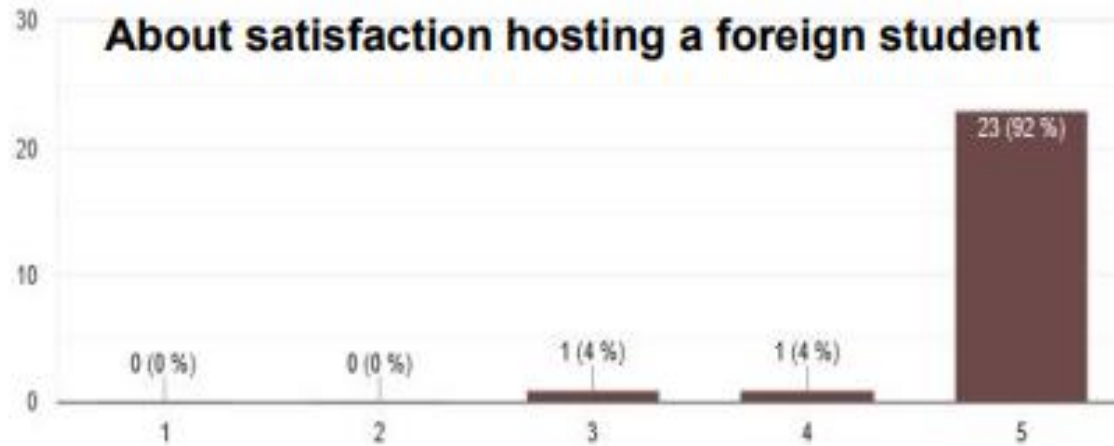

Summary of the answers:

The organization of the mobilities and family approach was very good.

In Finland the students liked the presentation about immigrants and the visits of centres for disadvantages people most. They also like the work on the Chart of Human Rights.

In Spain they liked most the visits of the Centres for disadvantaged people.

They also liked the cultural programme and meeting new people and speaking English.

The most frequent answer about the additional value of the mobilities was the new feeling of independence and trust they would be able to work abroad and gaining new contacts.

The parents had the same feeling – the higher self esteem of their children, their independence and better communication in English.

POLISH FAMILIES

- FEEDBACK ON THE HOSTING EXPERIENCE

- Full and adequate information before the visit.
- Well-managed communication with the families throughout the visit (e. g. info about the delayed flights, problem-solving calls during the mobility).
- Some problems with contacting the guest students before the arrival to Poland (the families who did manage to get in touch were very positive about it – it made the hosting experience easier and less stressful for both sides).
- Minor adaptation problems (2 families) – problems with following the visit schedule by the guest student or a misunderstanding between the guest student and the host student.
- All the families stressed the fact that it was a really enriching cultural, social and learning experience for their children.
