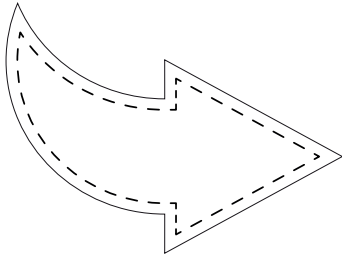
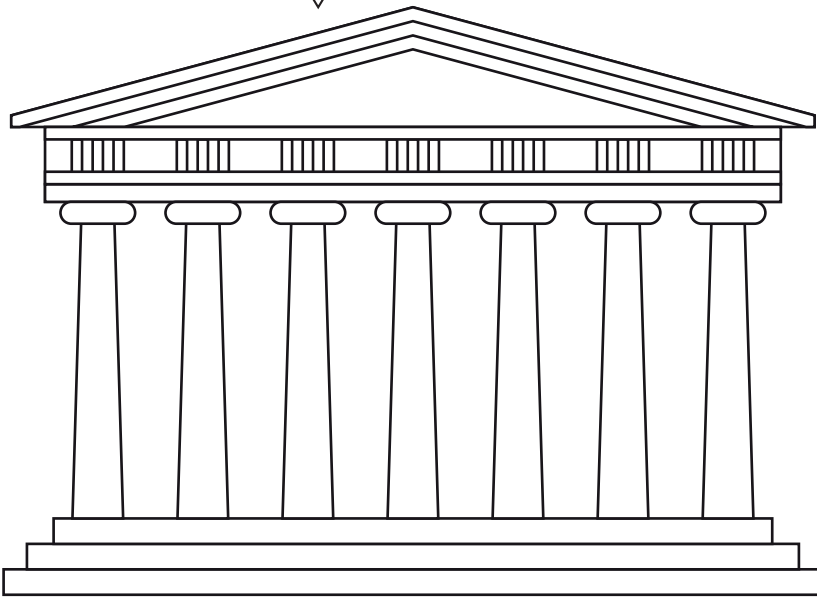
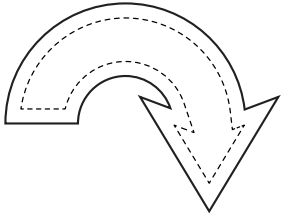

on the world level of Cultural and Natural Heritage

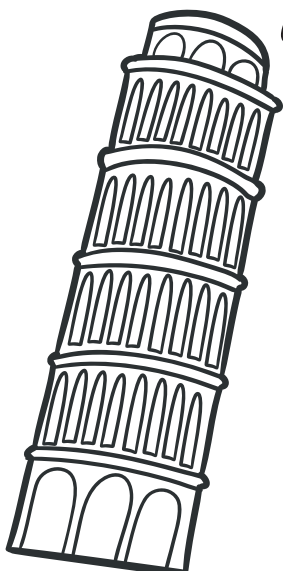
The World Heritage Convention establishes

exceptional universal

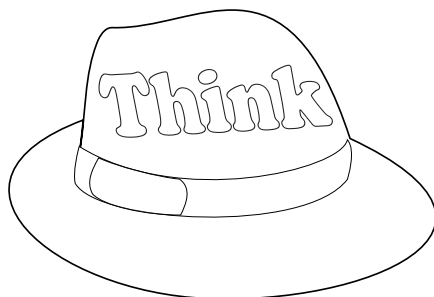
A World Heritage Asset is a product

a monument or cultural landscape

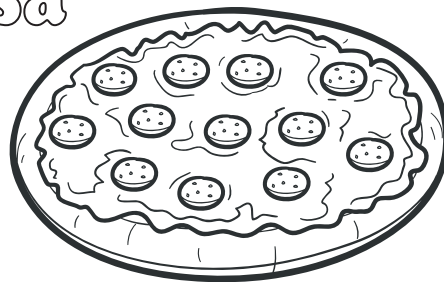
With 53 recognized assets, Italy is the country that
holds the highest number of World Heritage Sites.



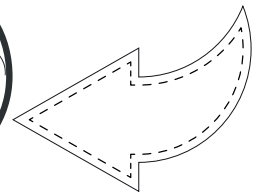
