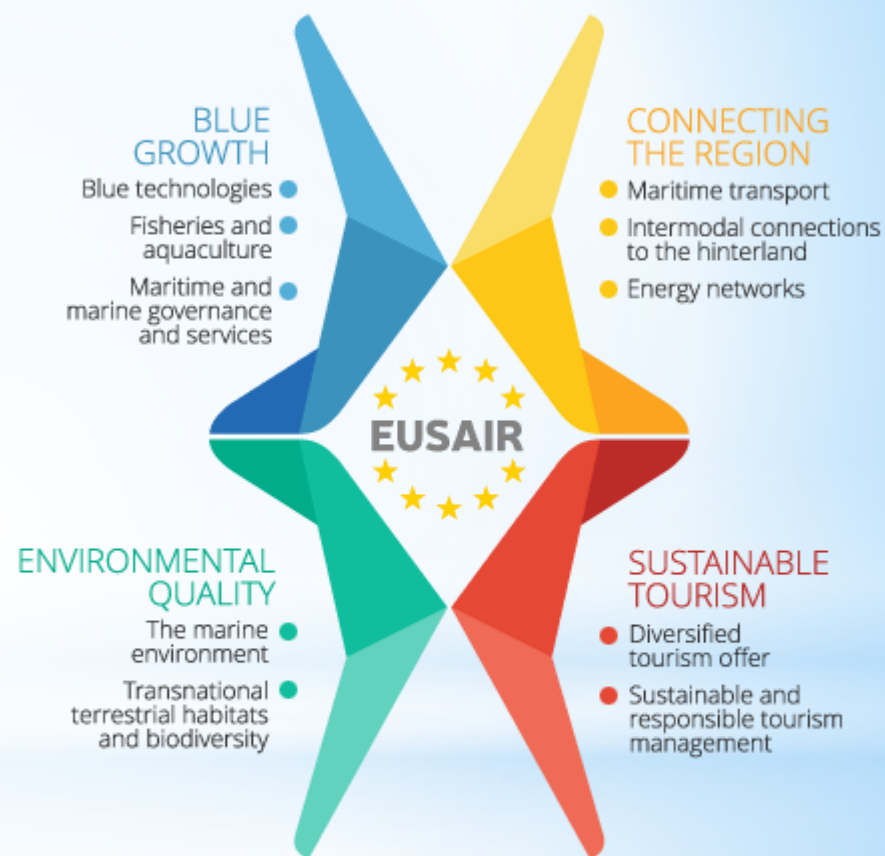

*'The Strategy aims at revitalizing the Adriatic and Ionian Region. It will enhance its economic development through four **priorities**:*

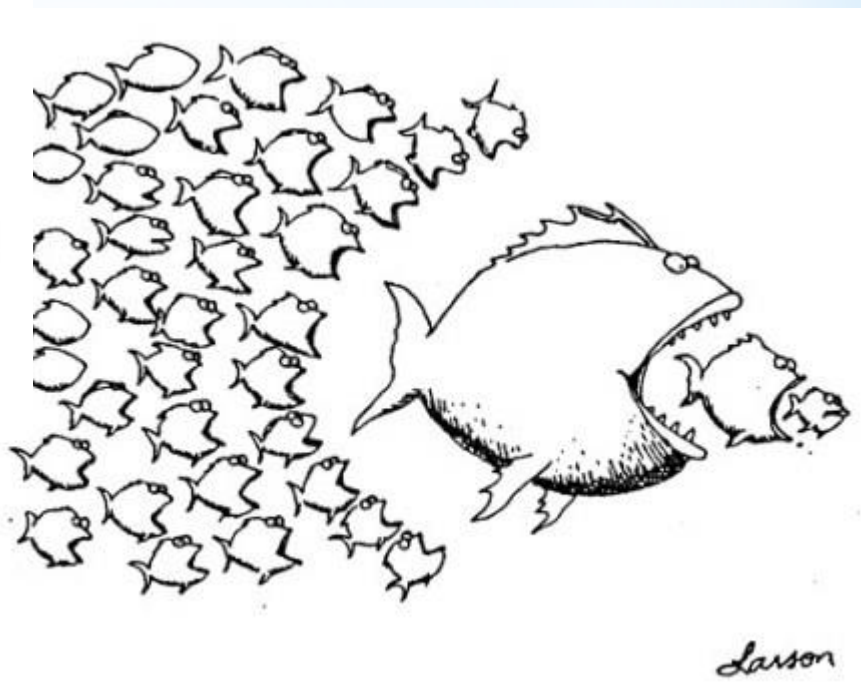
- * 1. *seize the opportunities offered by the "**Blue Growth**", i.e. by the assets of this large maritime area.*

In the context of the European Qualifications Framework(2008), competence is described in terms of responsibility and autonomy

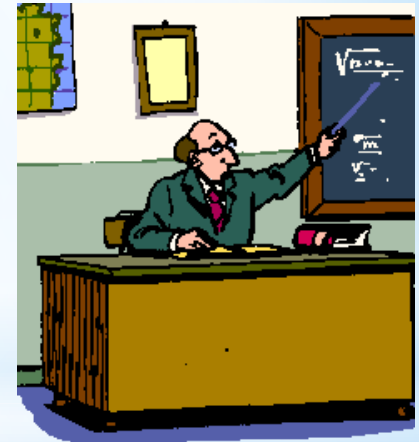

Connectivism

*George Siemens



- Learning is a process that creates connections and it develops a network
- To facilitate lifelong learning is necessary to feed and maintain connections
- Making a decision is itself a learning process

Critics to CONNECTVISM



Antonio Calvani:

A “wild” transfer of Connectivism into schools may lead people to believe that **it is enough to put the students in a network to produce knowledge**, thus consolidating the famous widespread stereotype that, **the more technology you use**, whichever way it is done, **the better is your learning**

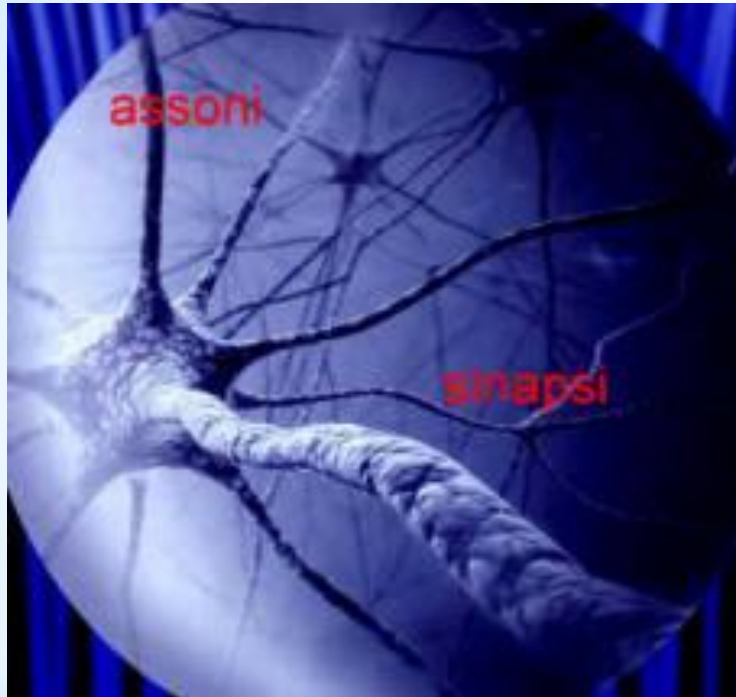
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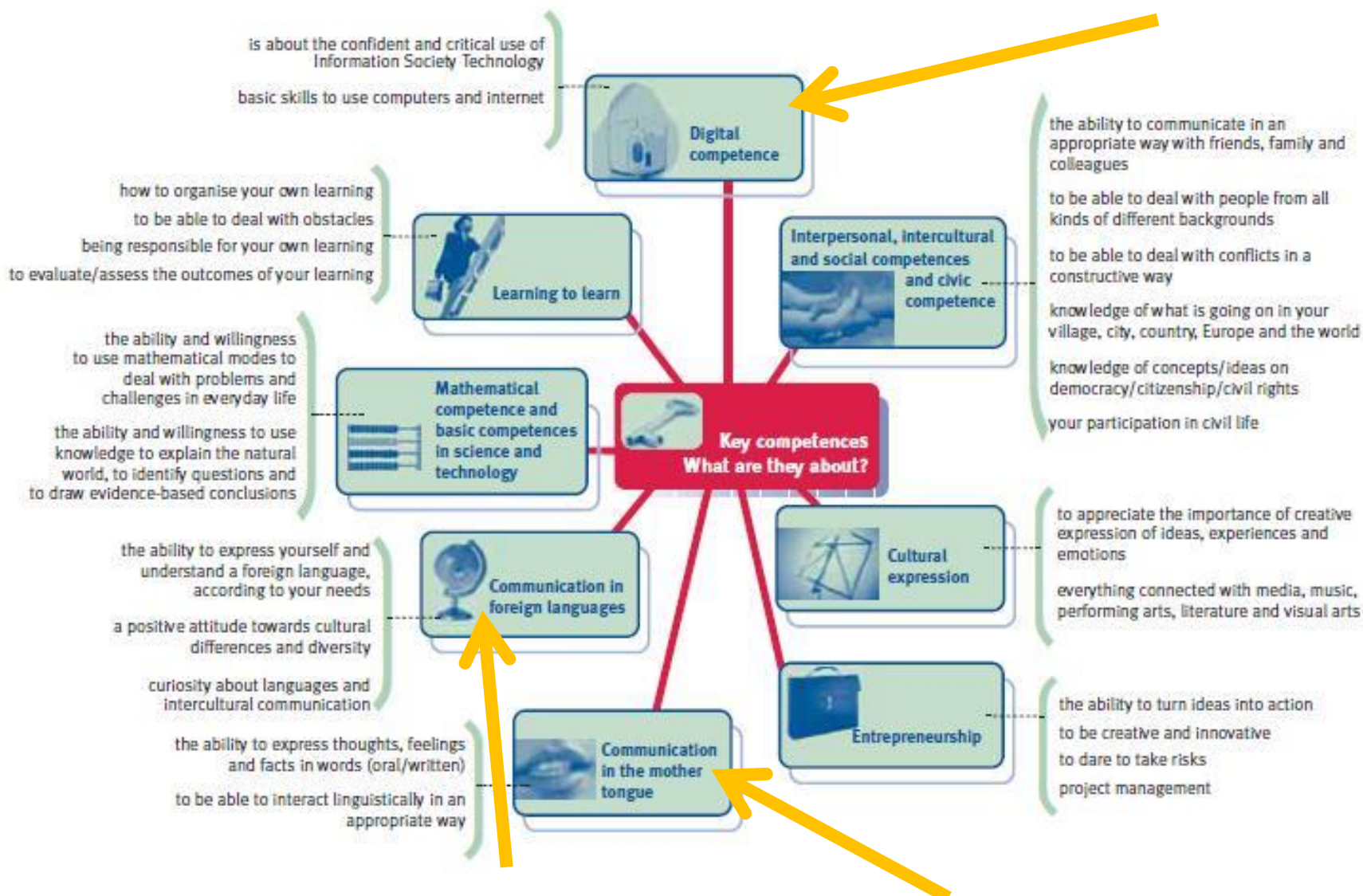

QUALITY of connections

to produce knowledge it is not enough to be connected,

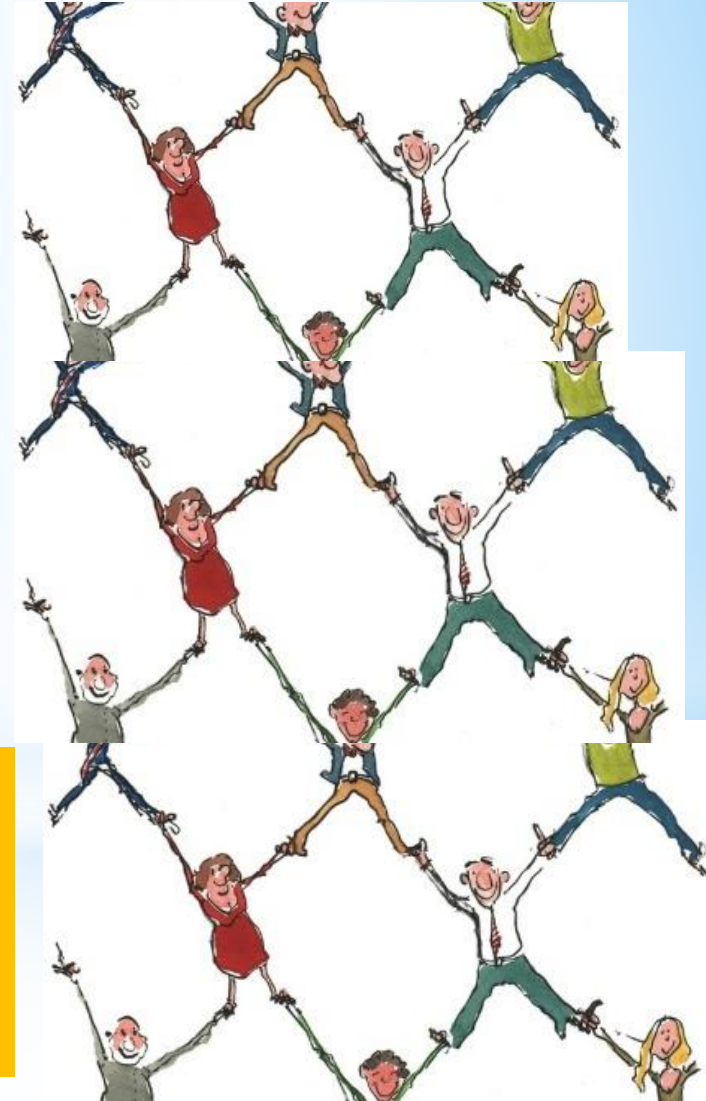

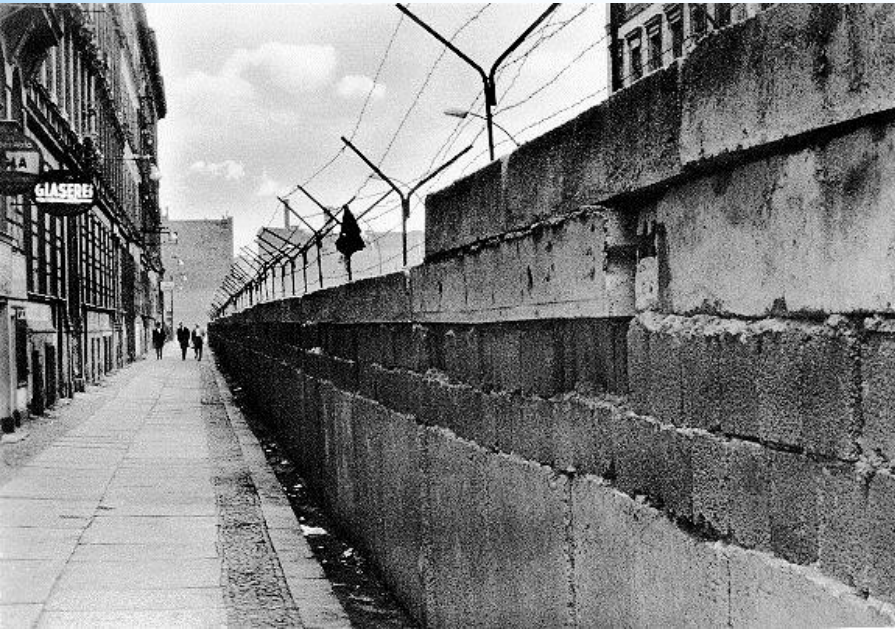
