



A 'competence' means the proven ability to use knowledge, skills and personal, social and/or methodological abilities, in work or study situations and in professional and personal development.

In the context of the European Qualifications Framework(2008), competence is described in terms of responsibility and autonomy









There is an increase in the offer of «digital job» in Europe, even in this period of stagnation, economic crisis and high unemployment rates»

There are around 500.000 digital jobs that are vacant because there no qualified people, and in 2020 the number could rise up to 1 million!

#### ERASMUS students: unemployment rate - 23%






## Connectivism

Learning is a process
 that creates connections
 and it develops a network

 To facilitate lifelong learning is necessary to feed and maintain connections

Making a decision is itself a learning process





#### Critics to CONNECTVISM



#### Antonio Calvani:

A "wild" transfer of Connectivism into schools may lead people to believe that it is enough to put the students in a network to produce knowledge, thus consolidating the famous widespread stereotype that, the more technology you use, whichever way it is done, the better is your learning







#### Critics to CONNECTVISM




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
**QUALITY** of connections
