STAGE 1: Desired Results

Established Goals:

- What relevant goals will this design address?

a) Knowledge Students will:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • get to know the segments of fashion using recyclable materials.
b) Attitudes Students will:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop a positive attitude towards fashion with recyclable materials. • Evaluate the idea of re-use in fashion.
c) Skills: Students will be able to:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Manufacture different types of fashion using recyclable materials

STAGE 2: Activities planning (**BEFORE OUTDOOR ACTIVITY**)

Introduction	The children see a picture showing clothes and answer the question: What's different from these ordinary clothes? We conclude that the difference is the material from which they are made.	Points to remember:
Activities / Experiences	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The children work in groups. They are invited to search the web and prepare a presentation for Recycle Fashion. • Each group presents its results in their plenary session. • Different fashion segments that use recyclable materials are identified. (Clothing, footwear, bags, hats, jewelries, etc.) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Materials: Computer Pictures ✓ Key vocabulary: Recycle fashion Reuse Clothing Footwear ✓ Key questions: Which is the most important advantage of using recycled materials in fashion? ✓ Differentiation: Depending on the time at our disposal, it is possible to give the presentation to children and to make only the discussion.
Conclusion / Plenary	The children prepare a list of materials that can be used in the manufacture of these items and are easy to collect.

It's an original topic that we have not dealt with again and for which we would like to learn more.

Initially the girls seemed more interested in the topic than the boys.

STAGE 2: Activities planning (DURING VISIT)

Introduction	The children present the materials they have collected for use in the manufacture of fashion items and are divided into smaller groups of 3-4 people.	Points to remember: ✓Materials: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Long jerseys • Jeans • Buttons • Beads • Ribbons • Hats • Slippers • Pieces of fabric
Activities / Experiences	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each team, under the supervision of the sewing teacher, decides what to manufacture and chooses the materials to use. • While the teams work they stop for a while and they show to the rest to the point they have reached. They receive feedback from the children of the other teams. 	
Conclusion / Plenary	The children try to complete their work.

Activities / Experiences	The children decide how they will present what they have manufactured. They reach the decision to prepare a fashion show, choose what they will present, in which order and what music investment they will use.	
Conclusion / Plenary	The children present their fashion show during the COOL GOAL Festival.
