ABSTRACT 1

ENGLISH LANGUAGE, ICT while exploring conflicts

Learning and using the **English language** as in real life through dialogues, role play and ICT along with the coursebook text each time.

The **issue** tackled is that of **'conflicts'**; whether inner or exterior conflicts, we look at various forms of conflicts experienced throughout life, their impact and possible resolutions. We have done many lessons on 'bullying', 'war', 'peace', 'human rights', 'independence', 'stress', 'happiness' which all entail the underlying issue of conflict and struggles for resolutions.


We practise all four language skills and encourage students to actively cooperate and use the language effectively in real life simulated situations. Thus they develop concrete knowledge of the English language while developing personal traits and skills in a **holistic learning environment**.

To consolidate learnt **vocabulary** students are offered the opportunity to use the familiar to them **ICT** through various creative fun activities designed with e-tools on a **moodle platform**, which will be presented to motivate colleagues to experiment with learning etools and Moodle platform.

Some **fun activities** are : sudoku, snake, quiz, poll, hang the butcher, reading text online, sharing opinion online, who wants to be a millionaire, crossword, hidden crossword, vocab list, vocab learning etc.
