- Pi is one of the most important and interesting number in the world?

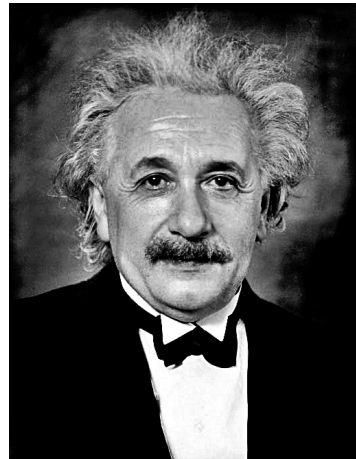


- Pi has been researched by scholars for hundreds of years?


WAYS OF USING PI
