Flower	The coloured part of a plant from which the seed or fruit develops.	Blume	Blomst	Floare
Leaf	A flat green part of a plant, growing from a stem or branch or from the root	Blatt	Blad	Frunza
Stem	The main long thin part of a plant above the ground from which the leaves or flowers grow	Stängel	Stængel	Tulpina
Bud	A small lump that grows on a plant and from which a flower, leaf or stem develops	Knospe	Knop	Mugure
Trunk	The thick main stem of a tree, that the branches grow from	Stamm	Stamme	Trunchi
Roots	The part of a plant that grows under the ground and absorbs water and minerals that it sends to the rest of the plant	Wurzel	Rødder	Radacini
Oak	A large tree that produces small nuts called acorns. Oaks are common in northern countries and can live to be hundreds of years old.	Eiche	Eg	Stejar
Beech	A tall forest tree with smooth grey bark, shiny leaves and small nuts	Buche	Bøg	Fag
Conifers	Any tree that produces hard dry fruit called cones. Most conifers are evergreen (= have leaves that stay on the tree all year).	Konifere	Nåleskov	Conifere
Spruce	An evergreen forest tree with leaves like needles	Fichte	Grantræ	Molid
Coniferous tree	Connected with any tree that produces hard dry fruit called cones A tall plant that can live a long time. Trees have a thick central wooden trunk from which branches grow, usually with leaves on them	Nadelbaum	Nåletræ	Arbore conifer

Hardwood tree/ Deciduous tree	hard heavy wood from a broadleaved tree/ (of a tree, bush etc.) that loses its leaves every year	Hartholzbaum	Løveskov	Copac cu lemn de esenta tare
plant climate zone	Earth has three main climate zones—tropical, temperate, and polar. These zones can be further divided into smaller zones, each with its own typical climate.
