On the 16th and 17th of January, took place in IES Valle de Elda the First Aid, Basic Cardiac Life Support and Defibrillators course organized by the health teacher Nerea Gomez.



In the course participated a hundred people among students and teachers of the Technical Degrees that are part of the educational offer in this high school:

The purpose of the course was to provide and improve the professional skills in the use and management of automatic and semiautomatic defibrillators and the different first aid techniques. Moreover, the course have try to strengthen the basic cardiac life support knowledge acquired by our students in the subjects taught by health teachers.



On the other hand, the course have reached the objective of giving an official registration to the students and teachers as authorized people in the use of defibrillators by the EVES (Valencian School of Health Studies of the Generalitat Valenciana)

- Transfers techniques
- Mobilizations
- Shock and fainting interventions
- Security positions
- Basic cardiac life support for adults and breastfed babies
- Defibrillators using
- Oxygen cylinder using
- Resolution of hypothetical scenarios
- Triage



It should be pointed out that this educational action is innovating in the public education field into the Valencian Community. It appears as a need of giving the best educational quality in the absence of resources of our high school.
