11.00 - 11.30 d.III.	A meeting on Zoom. Session II. Ceramics workshop. Part I: • A meeting on Zoom: the students will be instructed on making their clay items. Instructions will be shown with explanations step-by-step. For this part you will need: a piece of fabric / cloth to work on; any roller /rolling pin; a bamboo stick (for example, a skewer); air drying clay (air-dry clay; modelling clay, and any tools you might have for making a pattern (some texture tools, embossing tools or anything that fits the purpose, like a cap of a marker.	Since the clay has to dry before the ready items can be painted and turned into fridge magnets, the ceramics workshop was divided into two parts and the first part has to be done on Monday The instructions will be shared with the students during the Zoom meeting and uploaded beforehand on Google Drive in the Monday folder

9.00 – 10 a.m.	MUSICAL ACTVITY: INTERNATIONAL RAP SONG AGAINST DISCRIMINATION A Zoom meeting:	
	 The students will be instructed on the musical task: we will all be working on a rap song against disability discrimination. Our students have created the music for the song and the first verse of the text in Lithuanian. The text of the chorus of our rap will be a slightly changed version of the chorus from "Ode to Joy". It will be performed both by singing it in English and showing gestures in the sign language. During the meeting, the students will hear the record of the first verse of the song and the chorus. Each team will have to continue the song with a rap verse (on the topic of anti-discrimination) in their mother tongue to complete the song. As a result, we will create an international rap song with the verse in Lithuanian, French, Italian and Spanish (or Catalan) and the chorus in English and sign language. The final result will be presented on Friday in the Zoom meeting. - Using a video camera (or simply a smart phone) make a video of yourselves performing your verse (make sure the sound of the music track is loud enough to be heard clearly on the record). During the chorus show the gestures in the sign language.
- Together with your teacher upload the video of your team performing your verse and the chorus in the Wednesday folder on Google Drive

IF YOUR TEAM IS WORKING FROM HOME:

The ITALIAN team (since you are working from homes): after the morning session on Zoom, the students and the teachers should get in touch on your own Zoom meeting (or any other platform you're using) and together create your verse in Italian following the instructions. Also practise showing the text of the chorus in the sign language.

1.00 – 2 p.m.

A Zoom meeting II for the Italian team with the purpose of making a record of your verse on Zoom

We will meet again on Zoom with the Italian team at 1 p.m. To be able to make a good record, there should be **one** person rapping the verse you created. While practising the song, decide who will perform during the recording session. For the chorus everybody will have to show the gestures in the sign language.

At the moment I believe only the Italian team is learning from home. In case other teams start distance learning by then, we'll add additional times for the second meeting on Zoom for each country to make records of their verses
