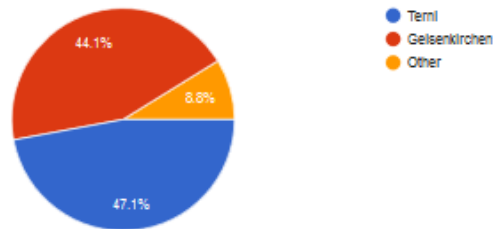

Where do you live?

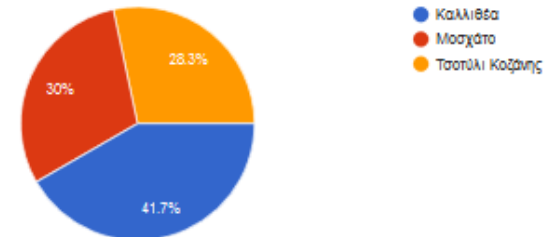

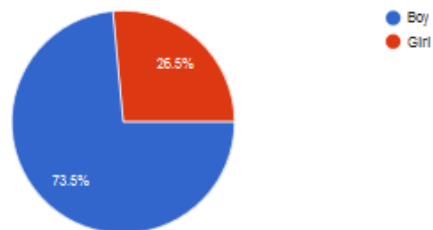

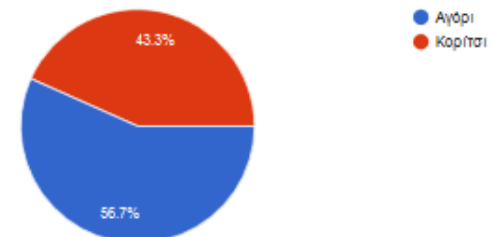
Which is your gender?

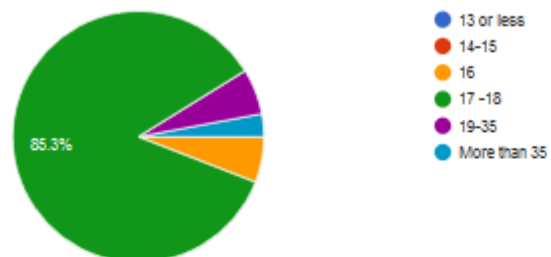


Boys constitute the great majority in Terni and Gelsenkirchen.

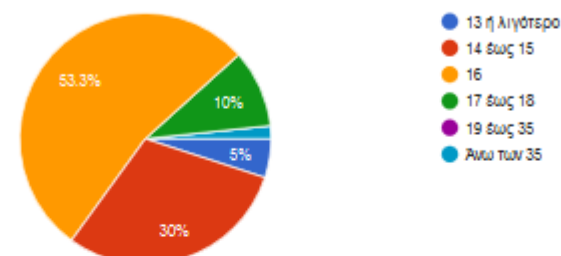

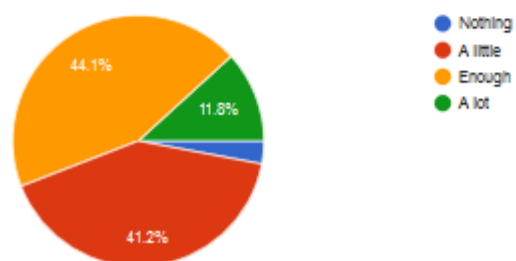

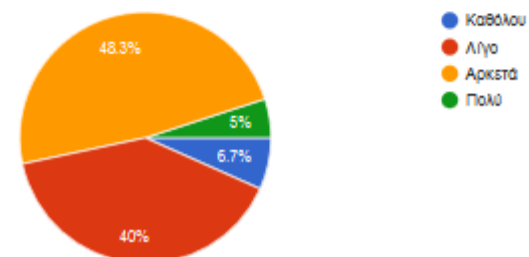
How much do you know about your area's animals?

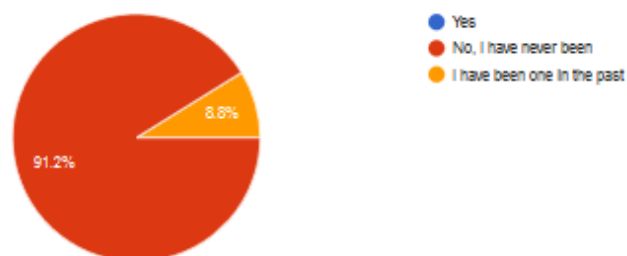

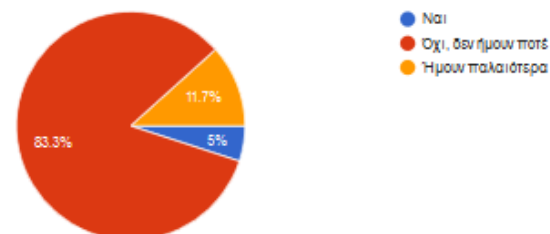

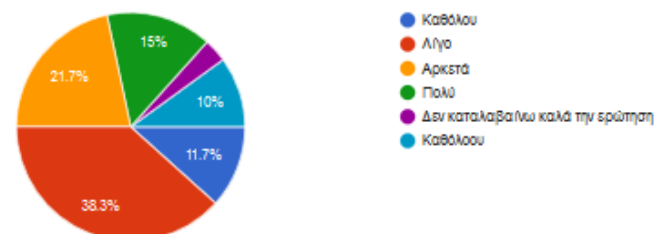
How much do you know about the wild fauna of your area?

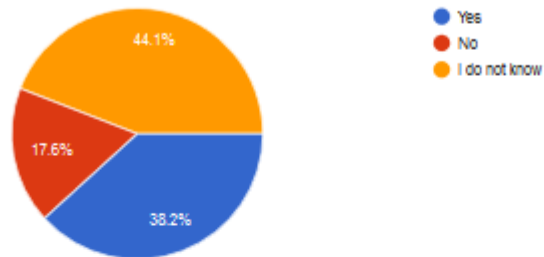

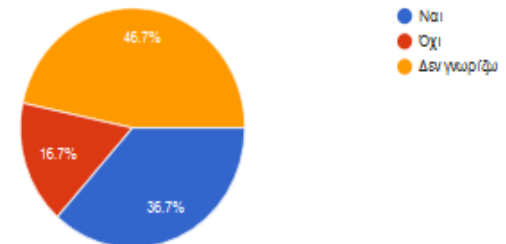

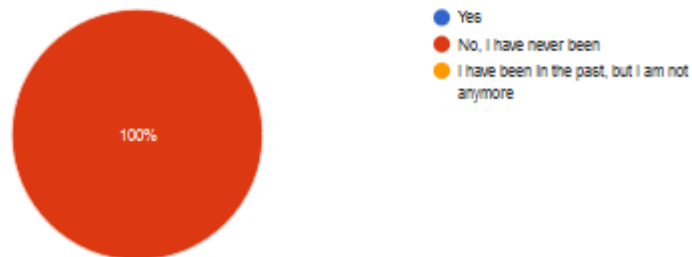

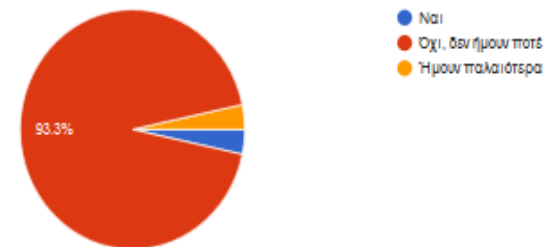

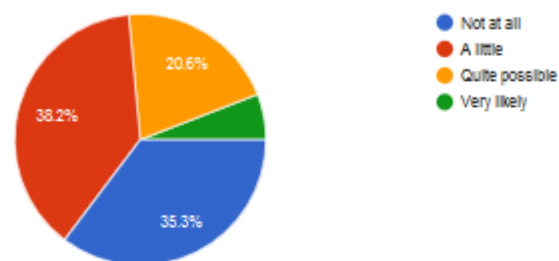

Not big of a difference between the answers from the different schools up to here. Nonetheless, answers are very didactic.

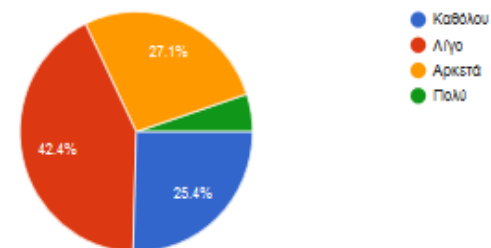
In case you are not already a member of a wild life protection organization, how possible do you think it is that you become a member in the future?

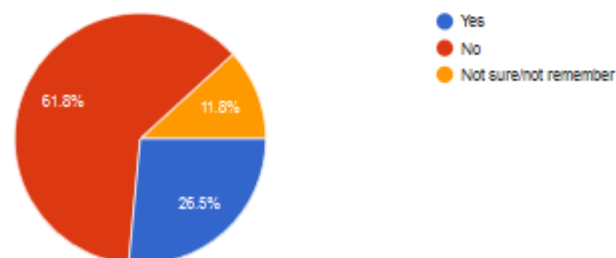

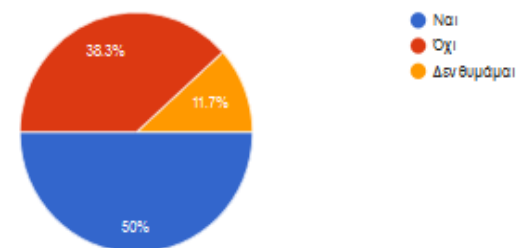

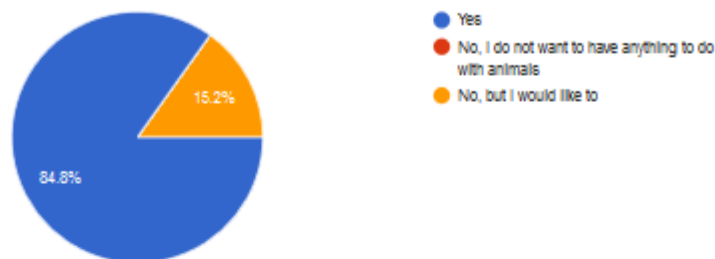

More Greek students (almost double percentage) have witnessed animal abuse of some kind.

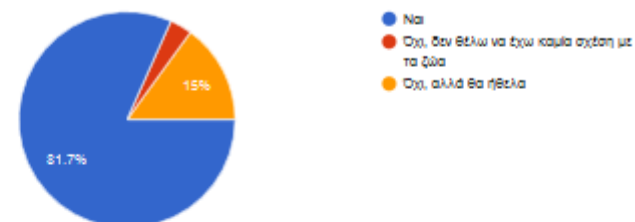
Have you ever helped any animal?

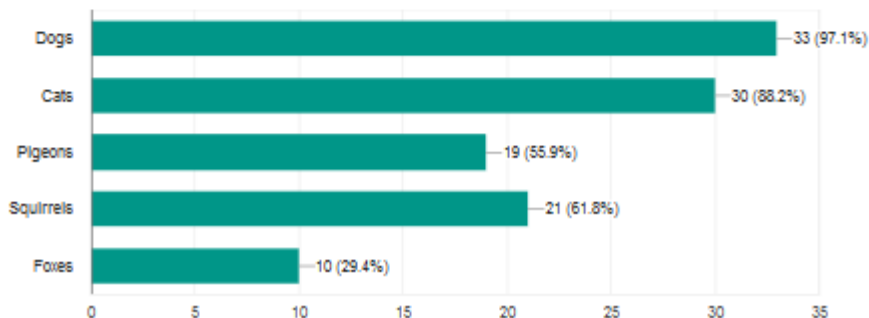

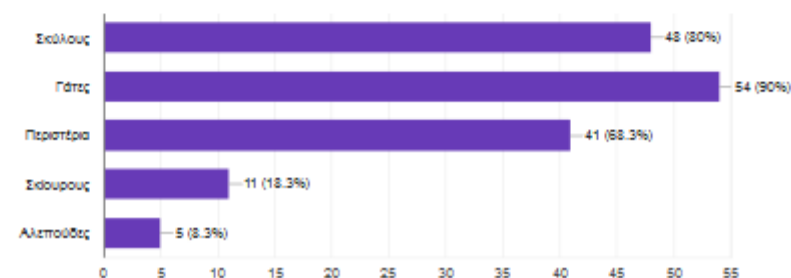
Which of the following animals do you see on a nearly daily basis in your area?

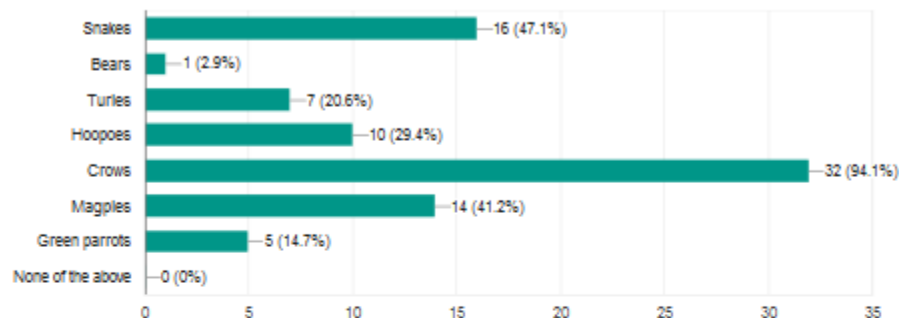

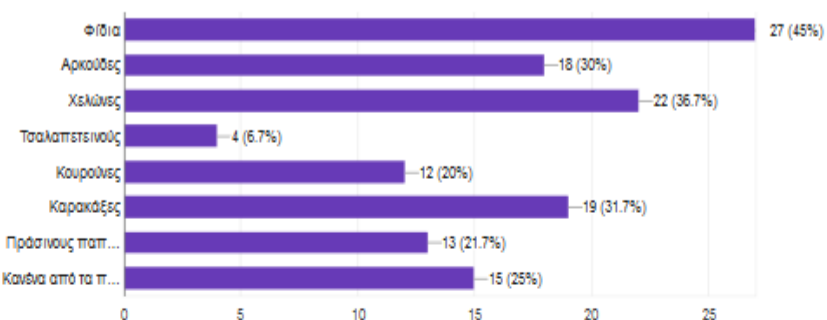
Which of the following animals do you consider it is probable that you see free in your area?

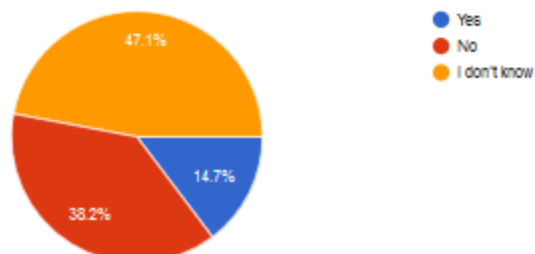

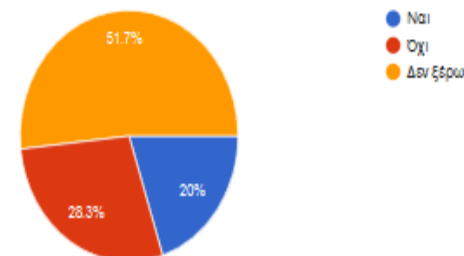
Do you believe that the aforementioned animals will disappear from your country in the future?

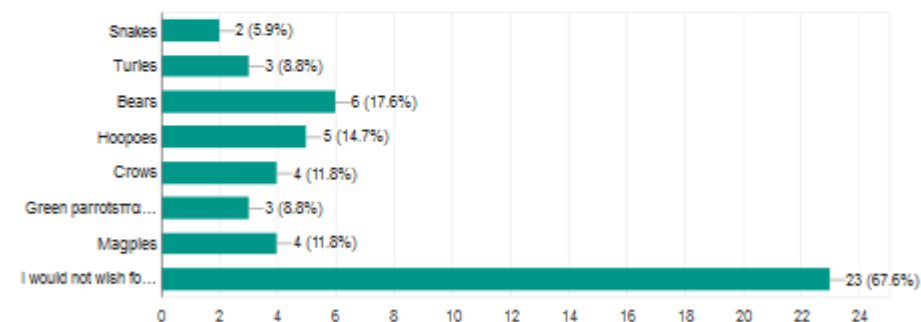
Surprisingly, a quarter of the Greek students believe they will not probably see any of the aforementioned wild animals. That means that the ones in Greek urban environments are convinced (not rightfully so) there is practically no wild life in the city. A piece of advice: be vigilant and urban wild life might surprise you!

On the other hand, Tsotyli students live amidst a breathtaking wild life reserve for many species, including -most notably- a large population of bears!

What is more, German and Italian students seem a bit more optimistic about the future of the wildlife.

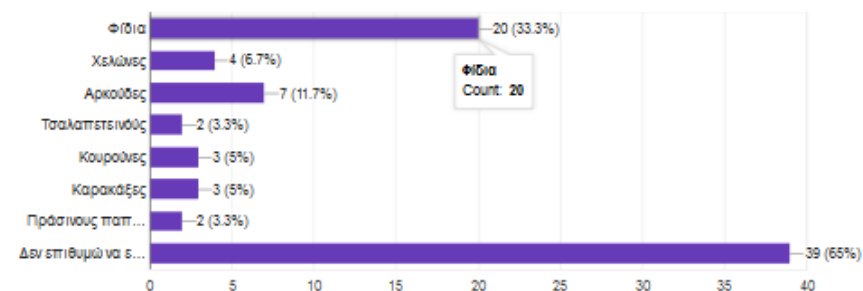
Would you like some of the following animals to be extinct from your country?

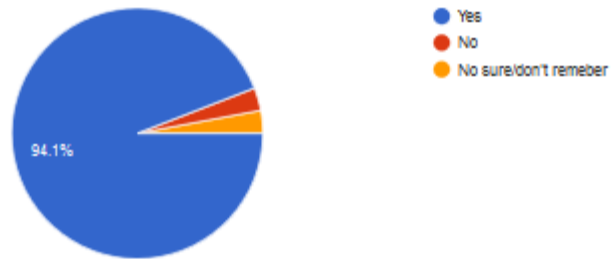

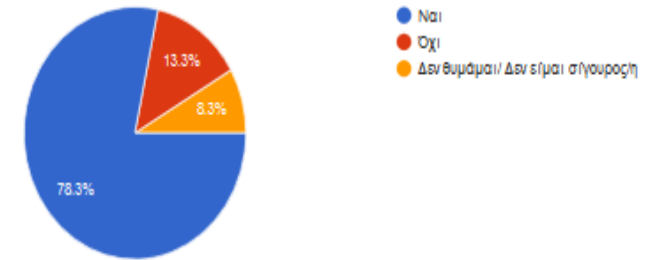

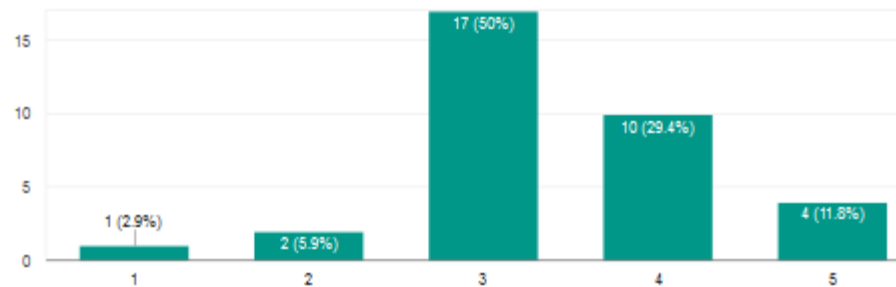

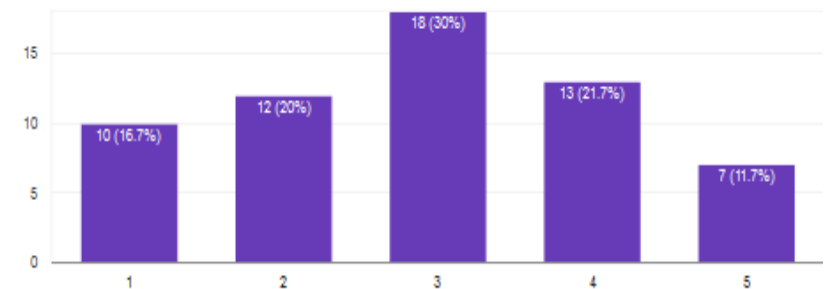
How solid is your knowledge about GM food?

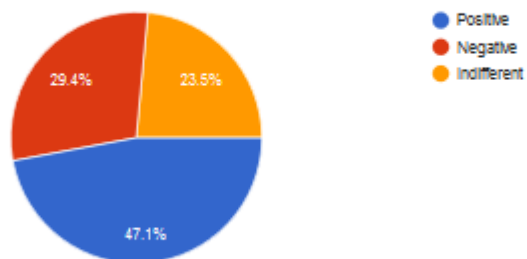

All in all, the majority of students from all three countries do not consider themselves to have a really firm knowledge of the GM food.

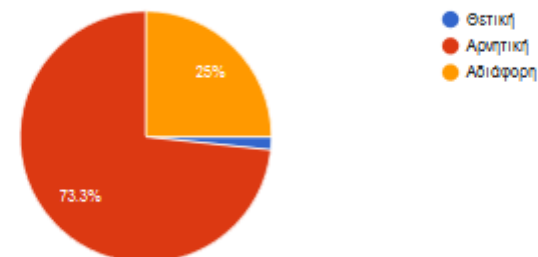
What is your opinion about GMOs (Genetically Modified Organisms)?

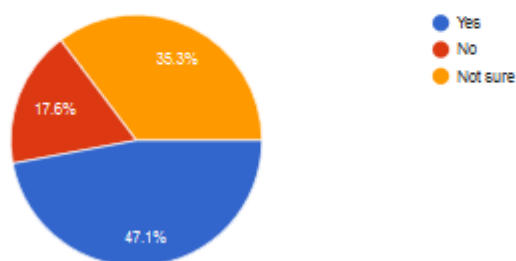

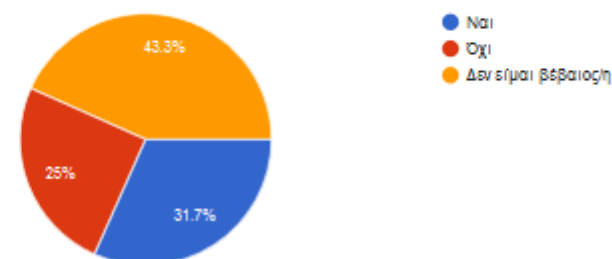
Do you know whether you consume GM food or not?

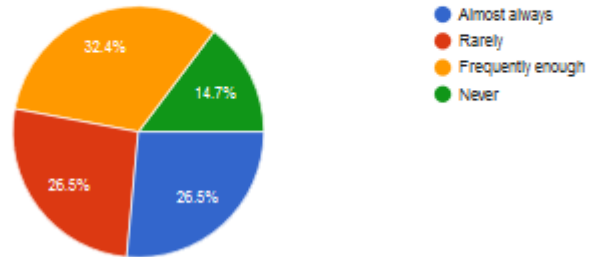

Here we are up against a major differentiation between countries. Italians and Germans are more conscious and informed as consumers. Most striking is the difference on their attitude towards GM food. Half of the left side are positive, while an overwhelming 73% of the Greek students are negative. Only one (01!) out of 60 students stated to be positive towards GMs.

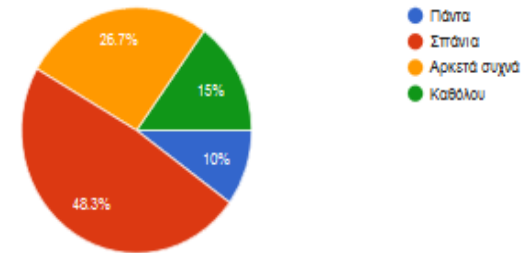
Do you check the labels on the products you buy?

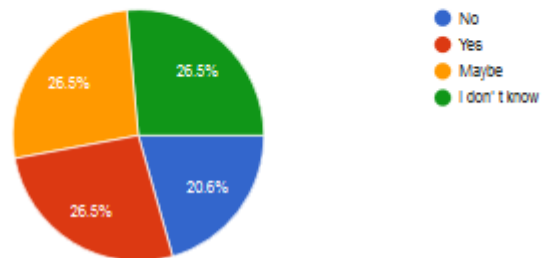

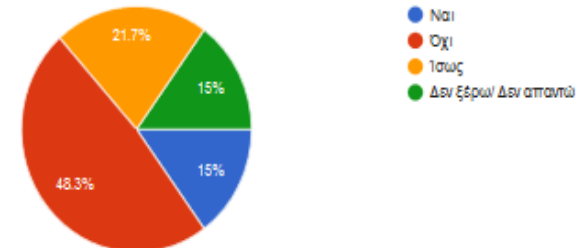
Would you buy a product if you knew it is GM food?

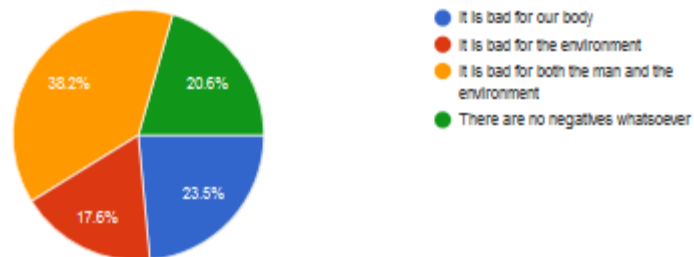

More consumer conscious and more divided on the possibility of consuming GM food are Italians and Germans.

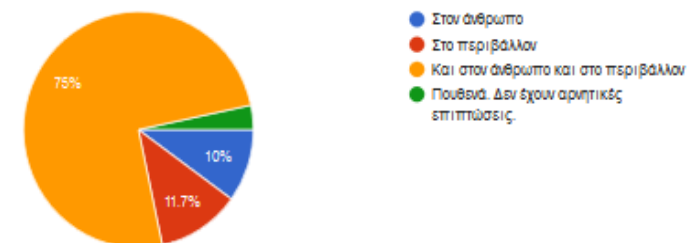
Which do you think are the negatives of eating GM food?

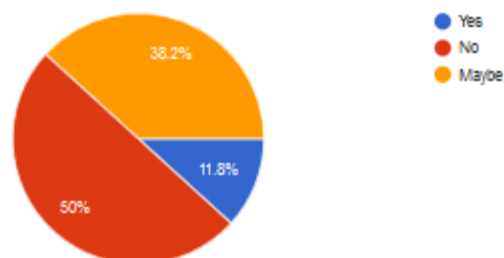

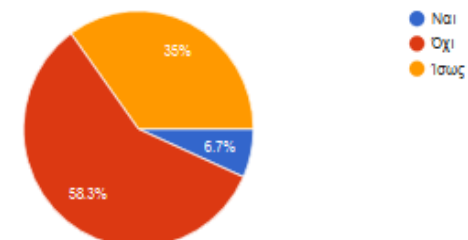

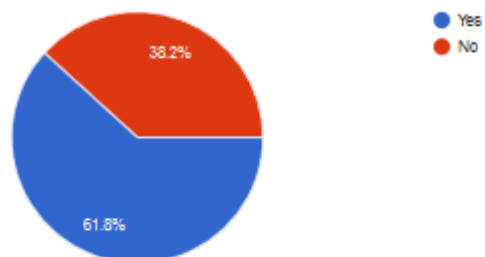

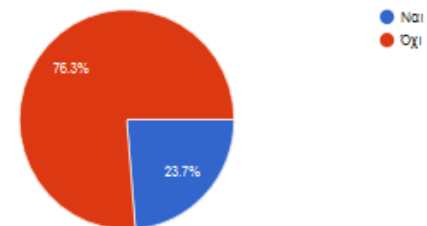

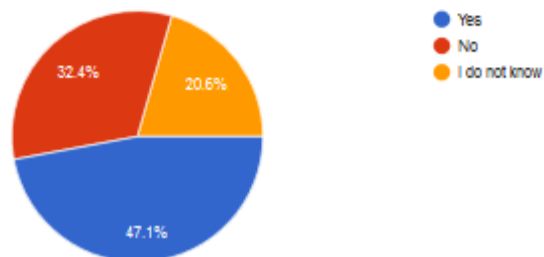

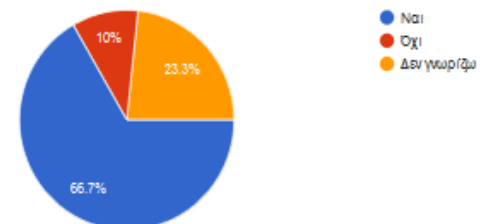

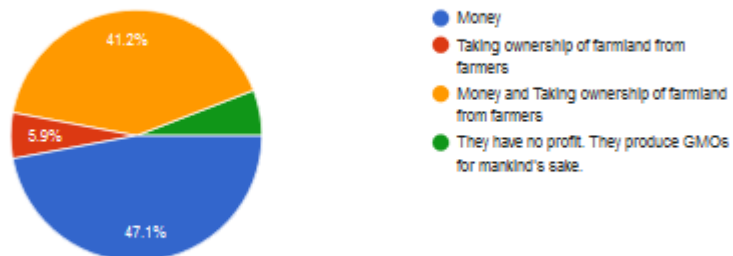

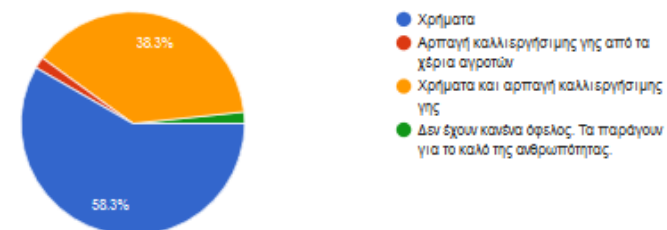
Which do you think is the profit of the companies that produce GM food?

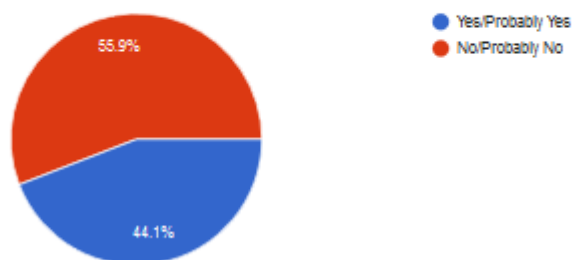

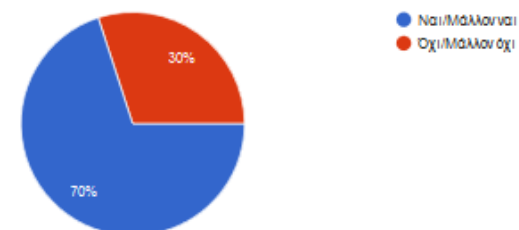
Do you think that in the future all food will be GMOs?

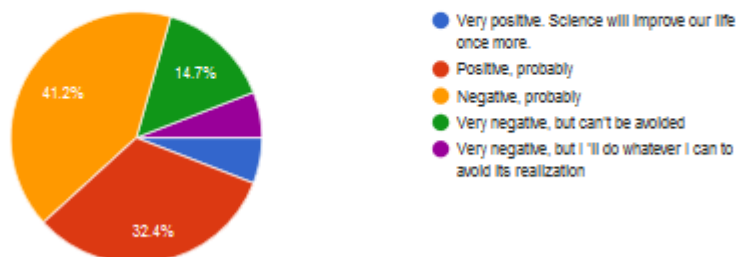


Money makes the world go round, as they say it.

The future of non-GM food seems more prosperous for students in Germany and Italy.

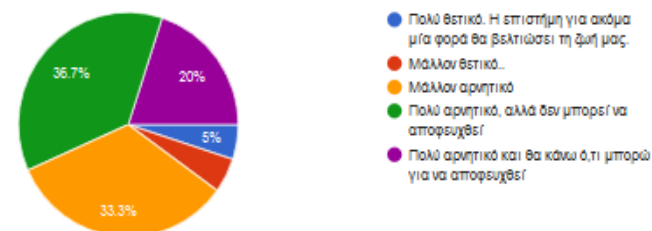
What do you think of the scenario according to which all food in the future will be GM food?

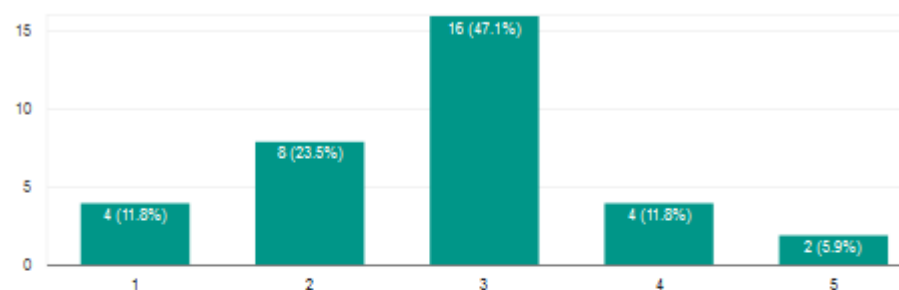

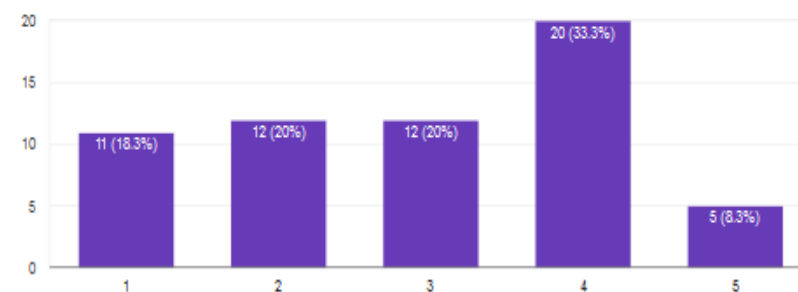
How much do you like your school building?

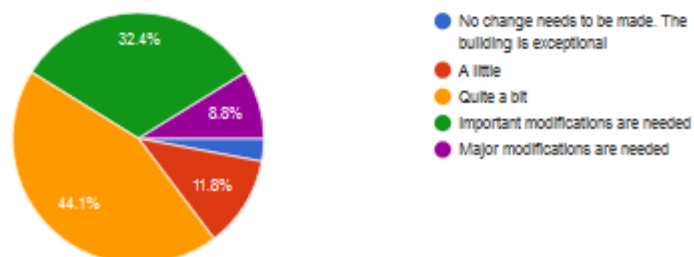

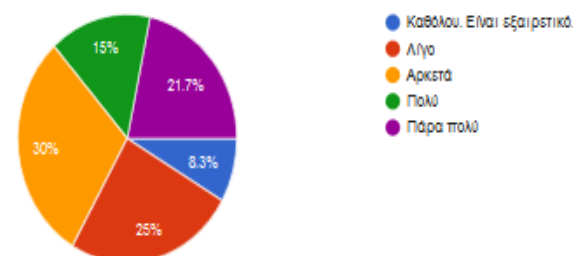
To what degree do you believe it is necessary to have your school building modified?

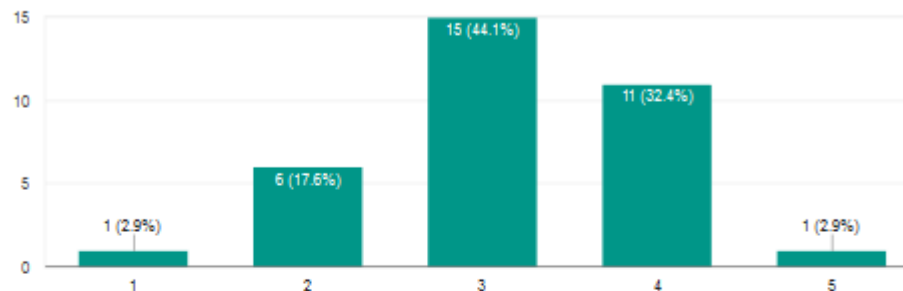

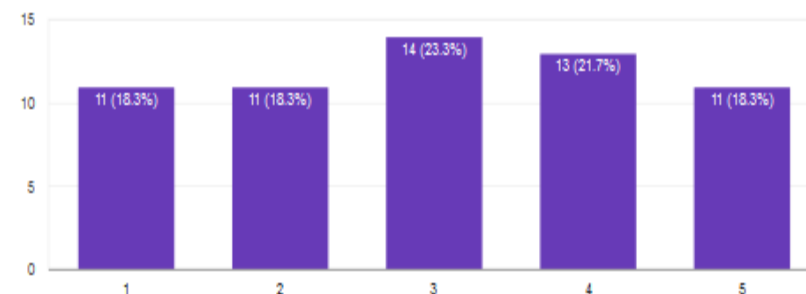

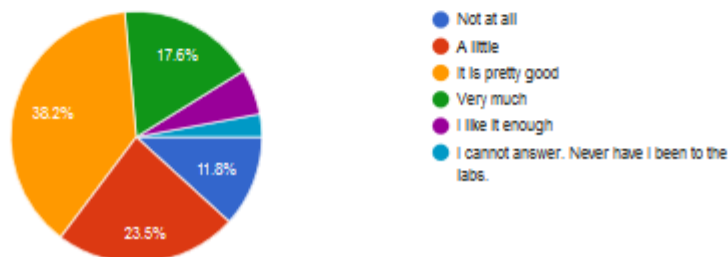

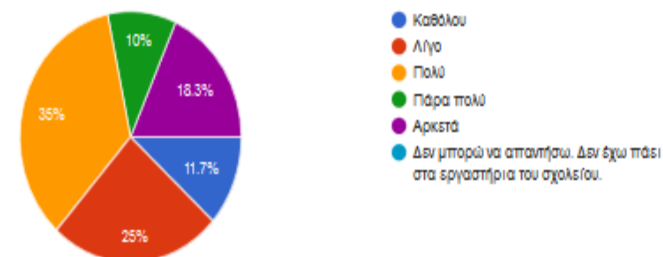

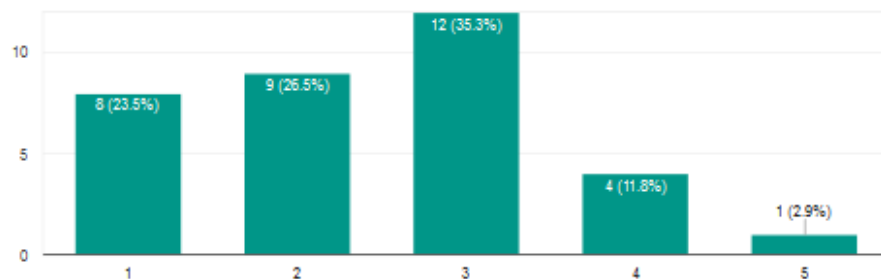


The most interesting answer is that, according to the answers, there are students in all countries that have never been to the labs. Could that be true?

Of course, the feeling of safety is of outmost important when having a lesson. The earthquake in Italy has left its mark on students' answers.

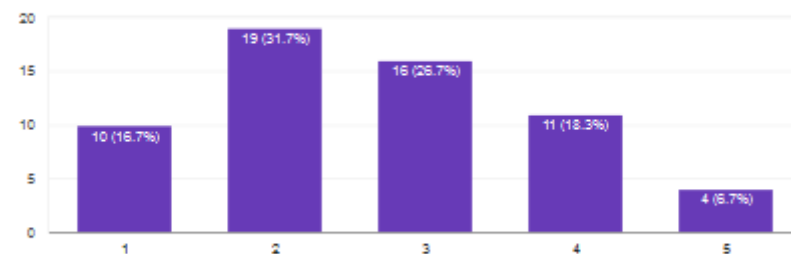
How clean is your school , in general?

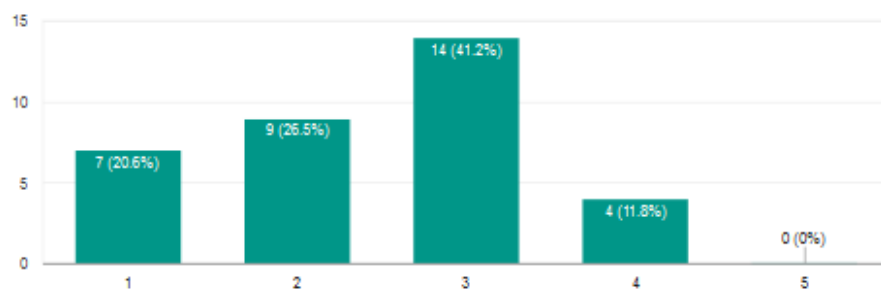

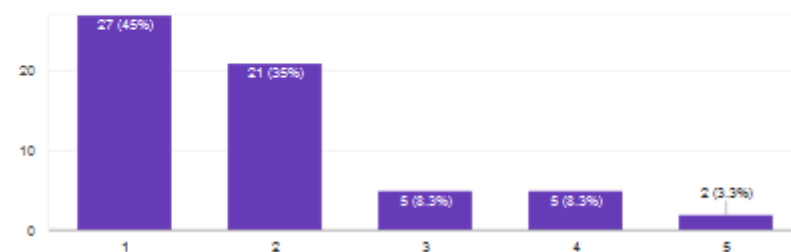
How much do you think that pupils contribute to keeping the school clean?

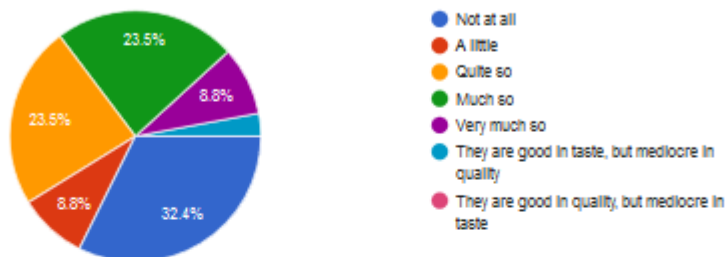

Relatively clean schools, albeit, especially in Greece, partly due to the careless attitude of the students.

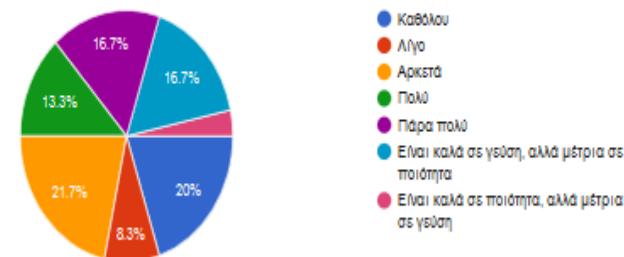
Do you think that the school canteen caters pupils with food which is good both in quality and taste?

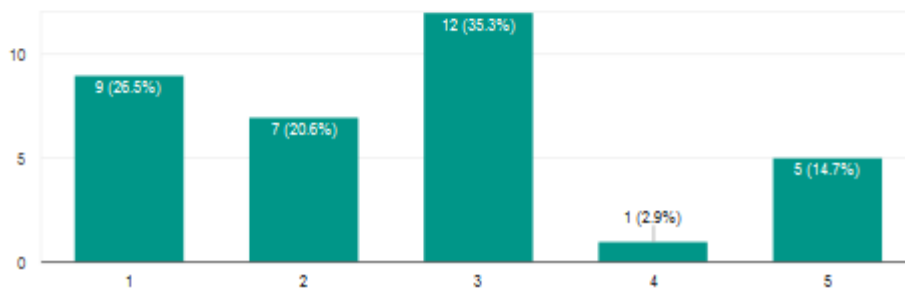

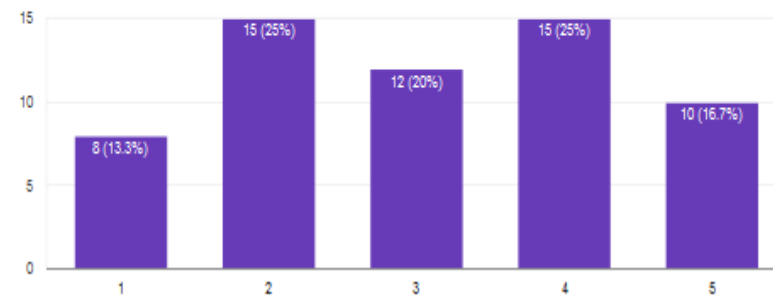
How much do you like your school yard;

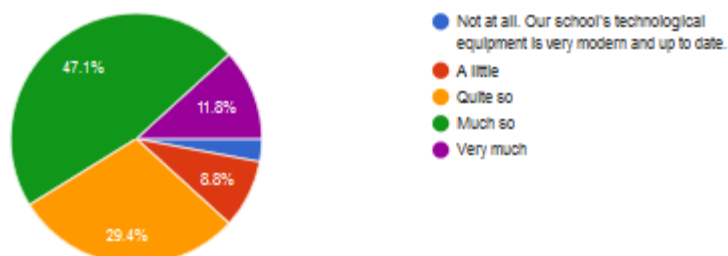

Nor very happy, neither too unhappy about the school yard. They seem also divided about the quality of the food at the school canteen.

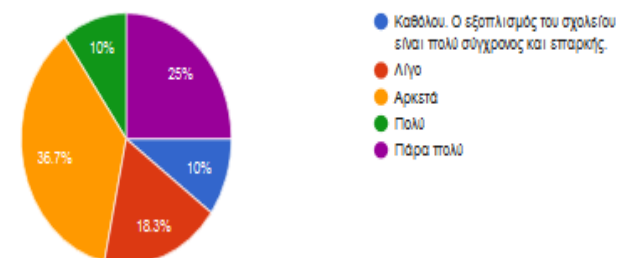
To what extent do you believe that an upgrading of the technological equipment is necessary?

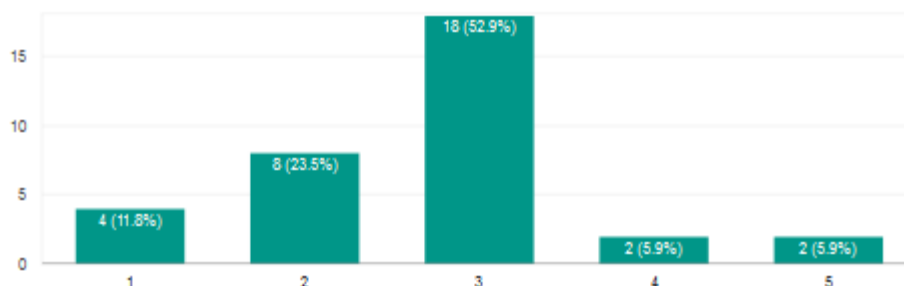

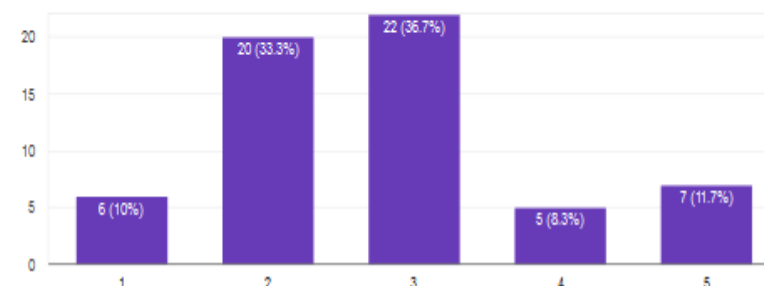
In case of a fire or a fire or an earthquake, to what degree do you reckon that pupils will be in danger?

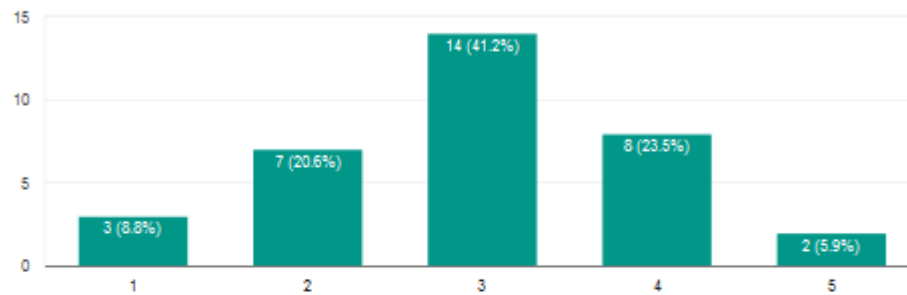

The question about danger from fire or earthquakes, comes as a supplement to the one about safety in school. It is imperative that the feeling of safety is established in the minds and hearts all pupils.

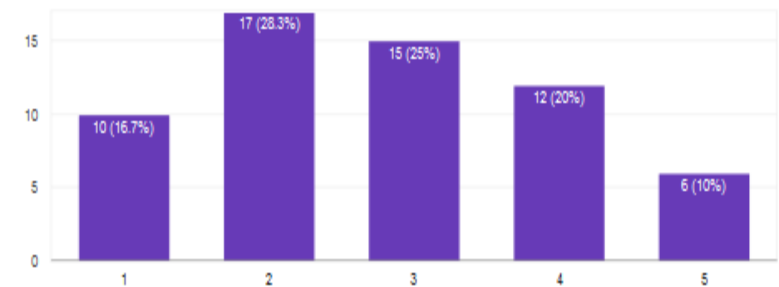
How ready do you consider your school to be in order to confront an earthquake or a fire?

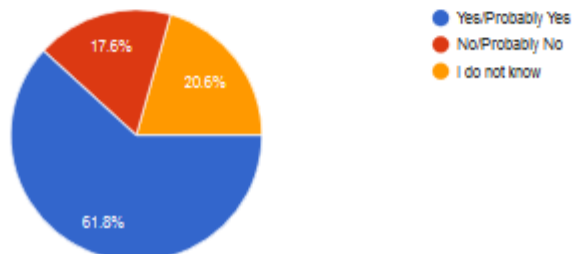

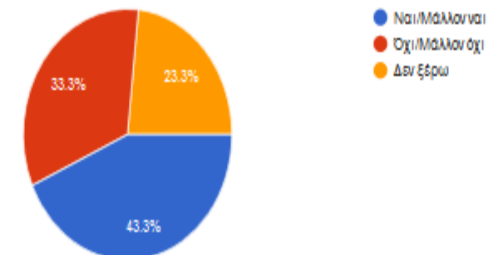

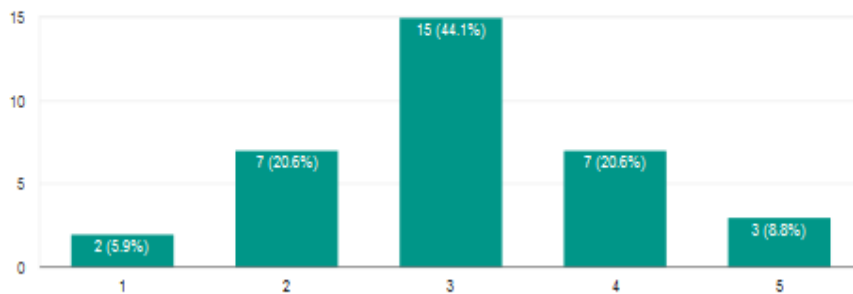

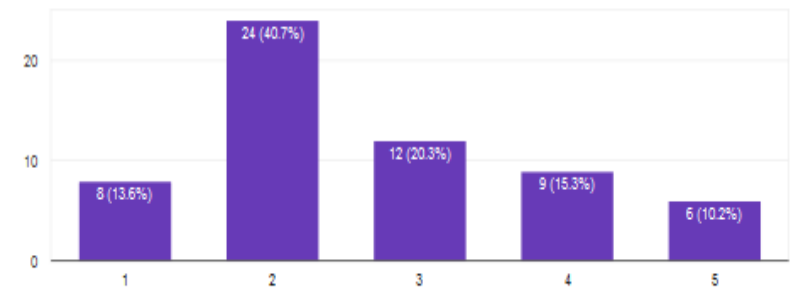
How much do you think that the school building will change within the next 7 years?
