How to get around the town?

The train station of Pápa can be found in Béke square. You can travel to every part of the country by the trains of MÁV (Hungarian Railways). There is a bus station in Pápa, too so if



you would like to visit small villages around Pápa or if you are planning to travel to the capital it is not complicated to reach your destinations.



For example if a family (parents and 2 children) is on holiday in Pápa decides to go on a trip to the capital, Budapest by train, the

prices are the following ones:

-	2 adults	\rightarrow	7830 Ft	/25.20€/
-	2 children	\rightarrow	4430 Ft	/14.30€/
			12 260 Ft	/39.50€/

If you would like to go from one part of the town to the other you can also catch a bus. There are several lines which buses run on so all points of Pápa are available. A single ticket costs 260 Ft (0.7 euro) but you can buy a season ticket which costs 1730 Ft /5.50 ϵ /.

Where to stay?

You and your family can stay at different types of accommodation:

What to see?

There are a lot of places of interest in our town. We are very proud of our main square which is one of the best preserved baroque squares in Central Europe. It is called Fő tér in Hungarian. In the middle of the square you can find the famous Roman Catholic Church called Big Church. If the family which we mentioned would like to visit this church, they just have to pay a few euros to have a spectacular view from the top of the building.





Behind the church you can see the Esterházy Palace. A guided tour costs 5500 Ft /17.70 ϵ / to the family. This is the price of a family ticket. In case you are interested to try some baroque costumes on you can do it for some extra euros.

Behind the castle there is a nice park called Castle Park where you can take a long walk under some really old plane trees. in the park there is an open-air stage, a spa bath with 11 indoor and outdoor pools, slides and slide tubes. The Várkert Spa offers a wide range of wellness services. Next to the spa bath there is a five-star camping site for tourists.





In the Várkert Spa the prices are the following for a day to the beach:

If you come to Pápa, you find some interesting museums here. It is worth visiting the Museum of Blue Dyeing in the 15th of March Square. It is unique in Central





Europe. There is a family ticket costs 2500 Ft /8 €/.

You can find a rich collection of the Reformed Church in the old church and in the college. There is a library and a museum there. You can see an Egyptian mummy which was donated to the

museum by an ex-student of the Reformed College from Cairo.
