
MAKING FRIENDS AROUND THE WORLD FINAL EVALUATION REPORT

Summary

A total of 27 teachers and students completed the survey by following this link: https://surveyhero.com/c/a1ff38b7. The purpose of the survey was to gather information about the activities done throughout the year, to see which were liked the most and which the least. By doing this, future projects could be improved. Even though most final evaluations only consisted of teachers, a small group of students were allowed to complete the survey. This was primarily done in order to see what the students' favourite activity was. The survey consisted of 10 questions which were clear and easy to answer. Here are the results!

What country are you teaching at?

12 teachers from 6 different countries answered the questionnaire. It was good that feedback was received from partners all around the world. Even though the chart below shows that 17 teachers from Spain answered the questionnaire, there were only 2 teachers that answered. The rest were students. Here are the results!



What age group did you work with?

Teachers had students as young as 5 years old involved in the project but as old as 12 years old. However, most of the students that were involved in the project were either 9 or 10 years old! A sample of the answers given can be seen below!

How many students were involved in the project?

The teachers were asked to state how many students were involved in the project activities. While one teacher involved 4 of their students, another teacher got the whole school involved and had 165 students participate in the project. A total of 391 students participated in the activities, a very high number! A sample of the answers given can be seen below!


Please select what activities your students have participated in.

It can be seen from the table below how many activities were carried out throughout the year and which the most collaborative ones were. In first place comes the comic book. This was the most collaborative activity and the one most students were involved in. In second place come the following 4 activities: video conferences, school presentations, the

board game and the digital escape room. However a great number of teachers involved their students in drawing the comic book cover, the original song and singing a song in a foreign language. The raw data for this question can be seen below!




What was your students' favourite activity?



Could any of the project activities be improved? If so, how?

This question was important so future activities could be better than the previous ones. There were a wide variety of answers given but some answers were confusing. One of the teachers said that English could be improved. Does this mean that the students' English skills weren't developed, the English instructions provided or something else? It was exciting to seen that many teachers and students felt that the activities could not have been improved. While some teachers said the guidelines were clear, one teacher said that the guidelines needed to be shorter. Four teachers felt that some students could have drawn better drawings for the comic book! One teacher also said that the school's Wi-Fi was a problem! Here is a summary of the answers given!

This question was added to the survey to give the partners to express anything at all regarding the project, the activities, the coordinators or something else. Here is what they said:


