

Card Set-Up

Front & back of cards are side by side in this document. Cut along solid lines, fold along dashed lines, trim edges. Tape or glue front side of card (questions) to back side of card (answers).

Game Set-Up and Instructions


Download and print the board template. Ask your students to draw the boxes with the 3 colours of the questions. Have more blue and orange as the questions on Tangible and Intagible cultural heritage are more.


Play the game with an ordinary dice. If you don't want to use the board and just play with the cards, you need to create a dice(template is available). Ask your students to draw 2 sides of the dice blue, 2 sides orange and 2 sides red.


You will also need to have the pie pieces., that players will get once they reply correct to the questions. The aim is to select 2 pies from each colour in order to win.




































Pie pieces template
