**Methodology**: Theatrical workshops. The methodology will be practical, hands-on, participative workshops, which focuses on the application of Theatre of the Oppressed, drama in the classroom and Peer Mediation. The input sessions are a blend of lecture format and practical activities.

**Expected results:** Provide the participants with an understanding of applied theatre, provide the participants with the basic techniques to start working with the Theatre of the Oppressed as a model for positive change in schools, a collection of teaching tools including activating dialogue, theatre games as metaphor, image work and role work designed to be used in conjunction with classroom curriculum. Provide the participants with an understanding of what conflict resolution an peer mediation is as well as with a collection of tools, materials and samples of this methodology to start implementing a peer mediation program.
