


Technologies In Reading; Modern Tools, Applications; How To Deal With Them

One of the Web 2.0 tools, Plickers is quite useful application to evaluate the comprehension of a book which has been read by all students in class. Not only students have fun while answering the comprehension questions but also teachers can figure out who has comprehended well or who hasn't immediately.

Teacher,

- Signs up Plickers.com
- Creates his/her library (questions) and class lists.
- Prints out Plickers Cards and download the Plickers application on his/her smart phone.
- Delivers the card to the class and displays the questions on the screen of a computer.
- Scans the answers of the students by his/her smart phone.
- Downloads the scoresheets of the students.


















