



## SOME GENERAL TRENDS

- Compared to previous years, there are more people who want to put a limitation to the number of migrants arriving in Italy
- In general, it's positive that more and more people have relationships, sometimes close ones, with people who have a different nationality
- And on the whole lots of people think that migration is positive for our community and is an enrichment to our society.
- However lots of people are not okay with the presence of migrants and refugees but they don't do anything to solve this problem
- It appears that young people participate to more formative events than older people, probably because they talk about it a lot at school







## WHAT WAS SHOCKING?

It was quite shocking to see that a high percentage of people, including students, want to limit the number of migrants coming to Italy. And about 50% of people don't want to invest money on this issue. However few people (about 30 %) get informed constantly about migration and its causes and effects.

## WHAT WAS INTERESTING?

It was interesting to know that on the whole people think that migrants can have a positive influence on our society. This contrasts with the fact that most people want to limit numbers and money.

## WHAT WAS POSITIVE?

It was positive to know that almost 70% of the people who answered the questionnaire have frequent or close contacts with migrants or people from different nationalities, which means that there is a positive attitude towards integration.
