

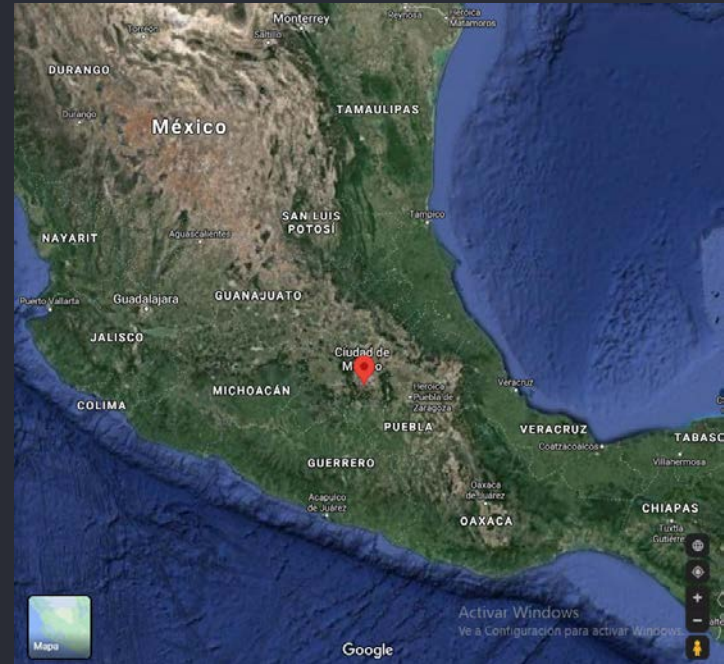
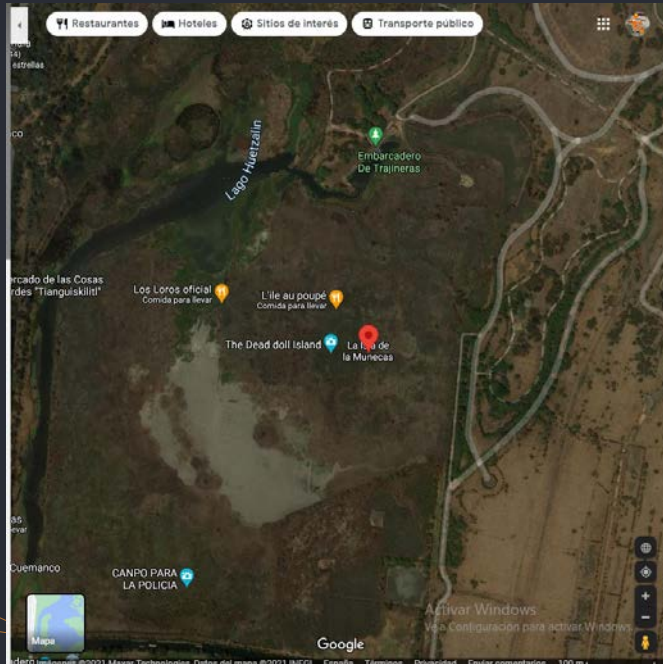

# WHERE IS IT?
