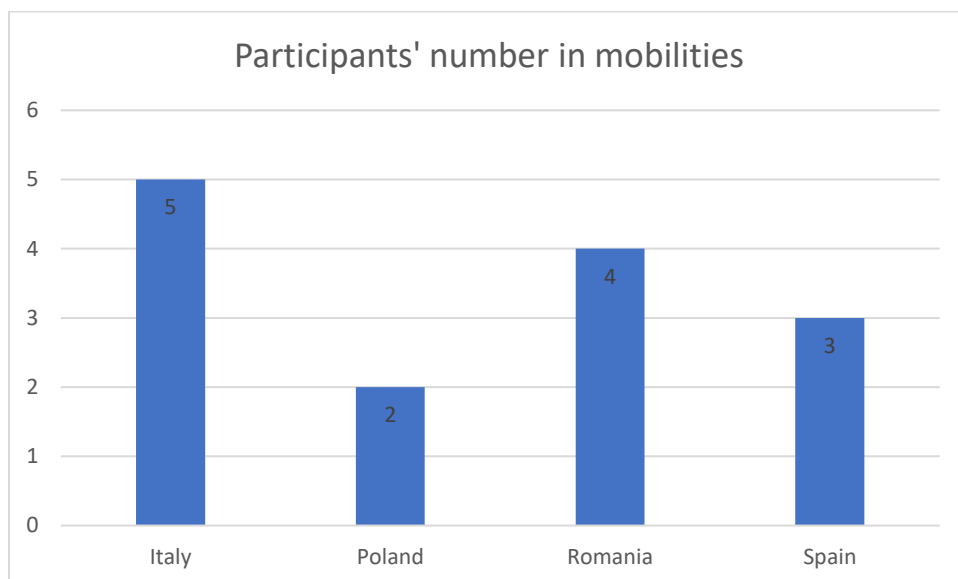

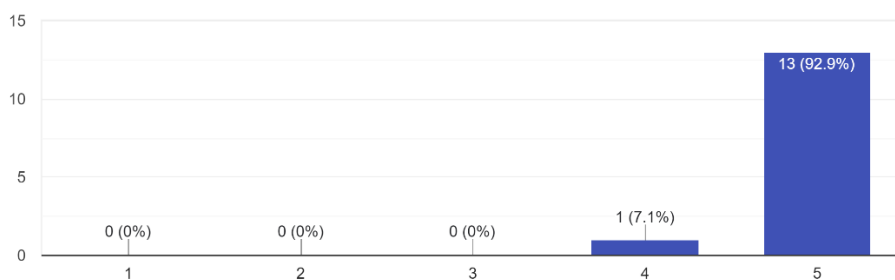

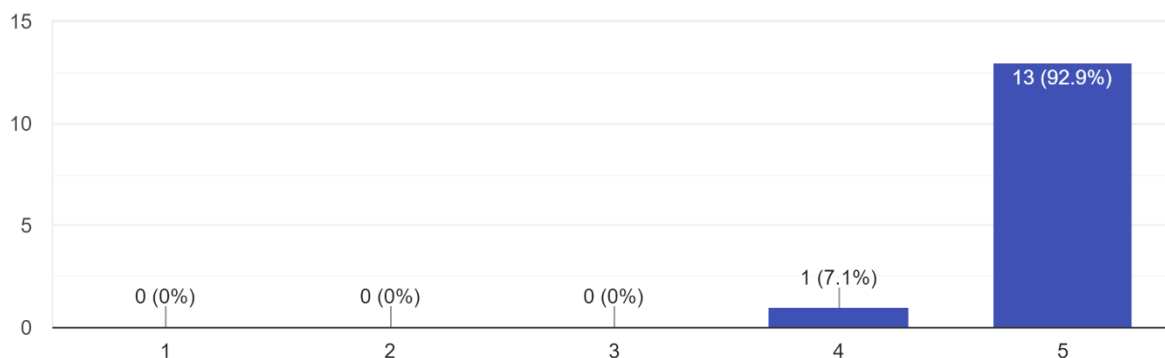

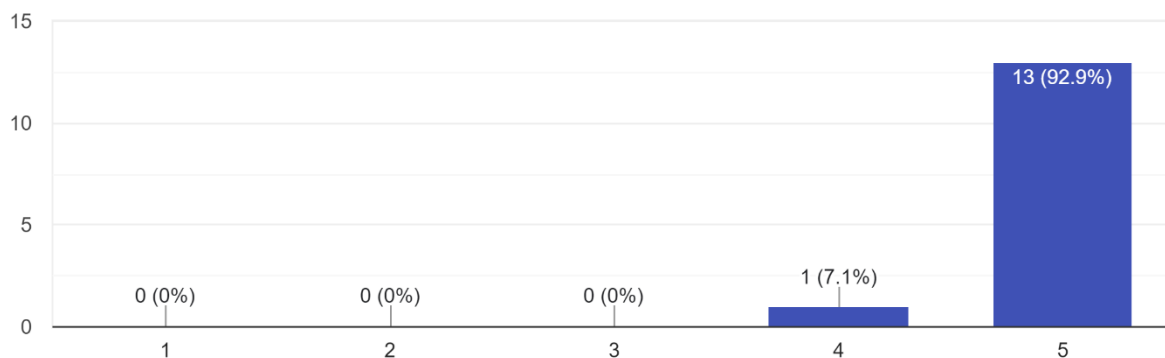
Rate the initial informative talk about the Erasmus+ program prior to mobility (1 lowest score and 5 highest score)

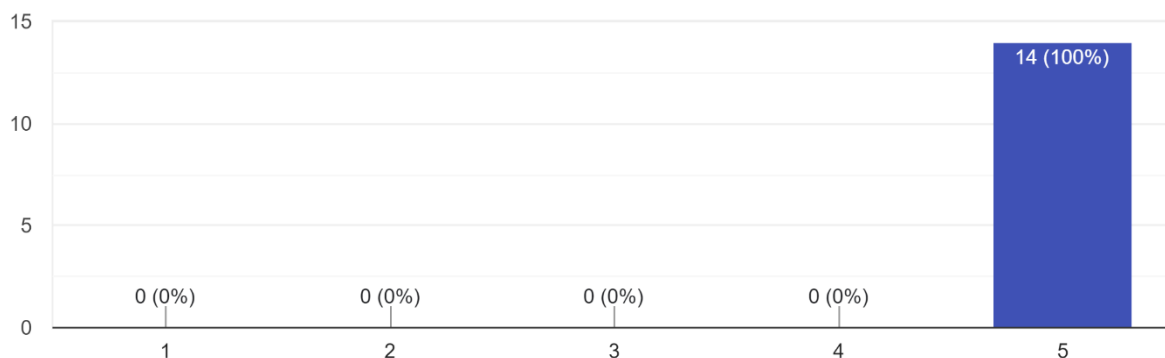

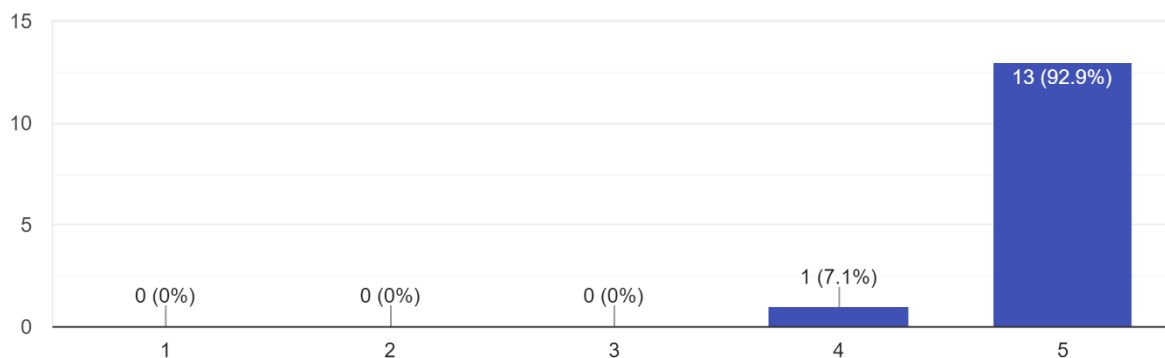
Values the involvement of the team of teachers in charge of the SUEO "A.S.Pushkin" (1 lowest score and 5 highest score)

Values the involvement and help of the person(s) in the mobility destination (1 lowest score and 5 highest score)

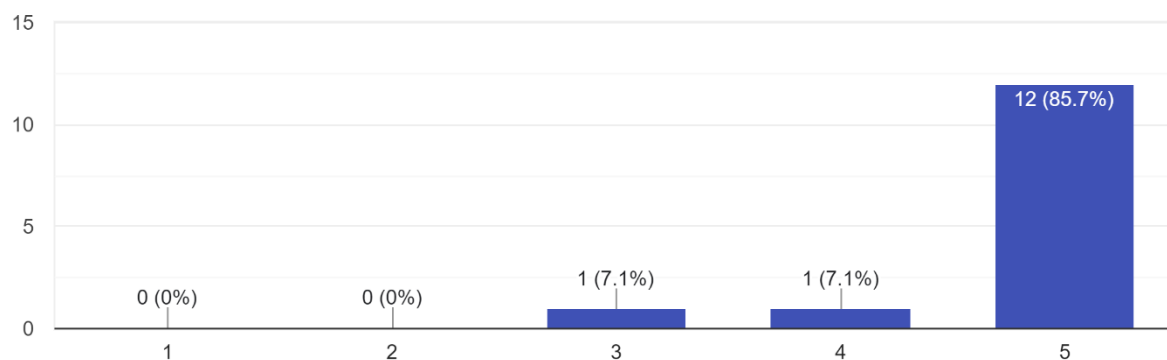

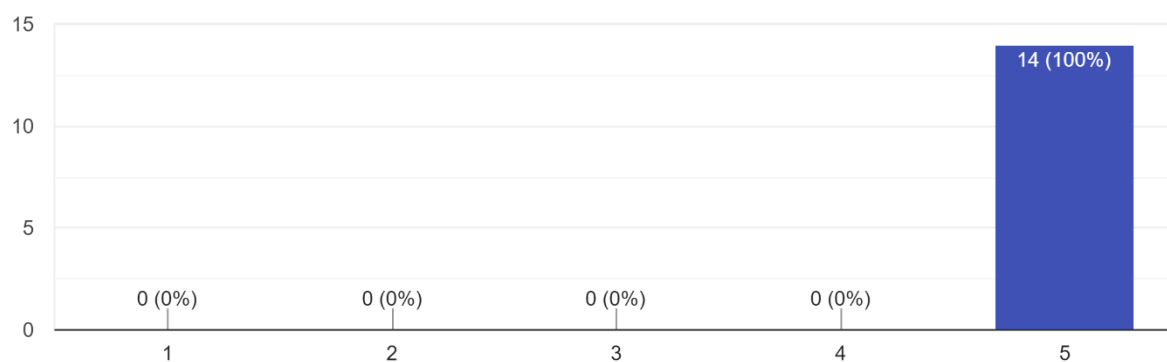
Assess the destination center of your mobility (1 lowest score and 5 highest score)

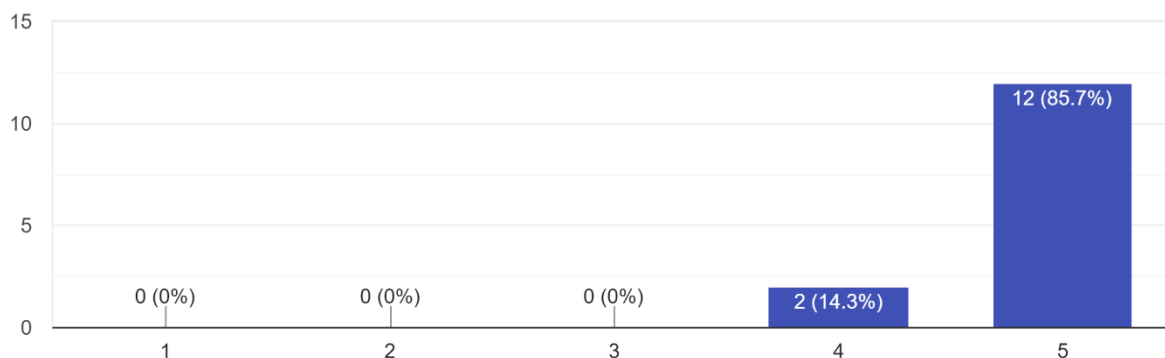

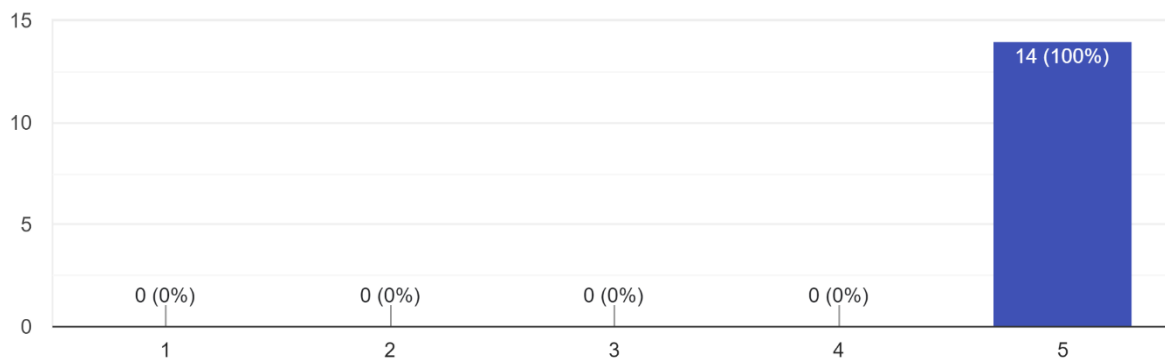
Evaluate the development of your communication skills in the foreign language (1 lowest score and 5 highest score)

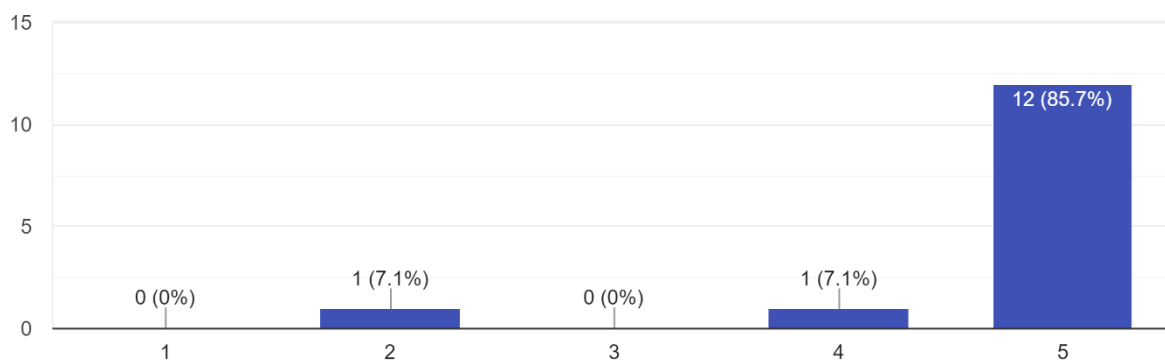

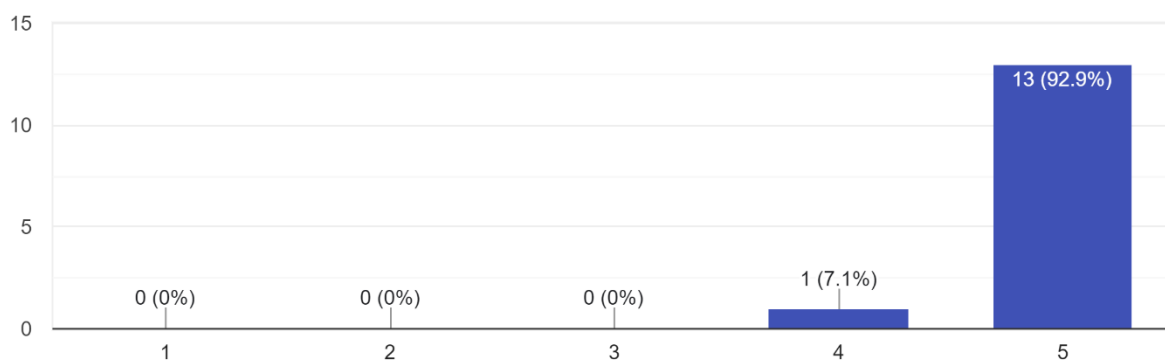

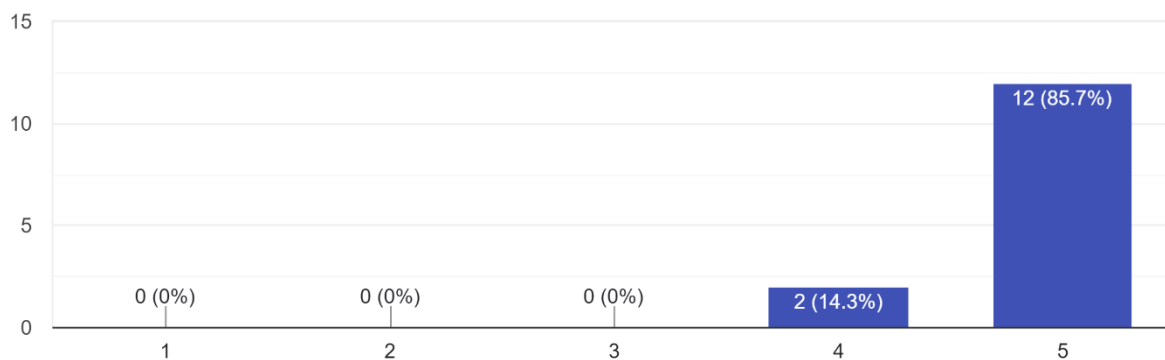

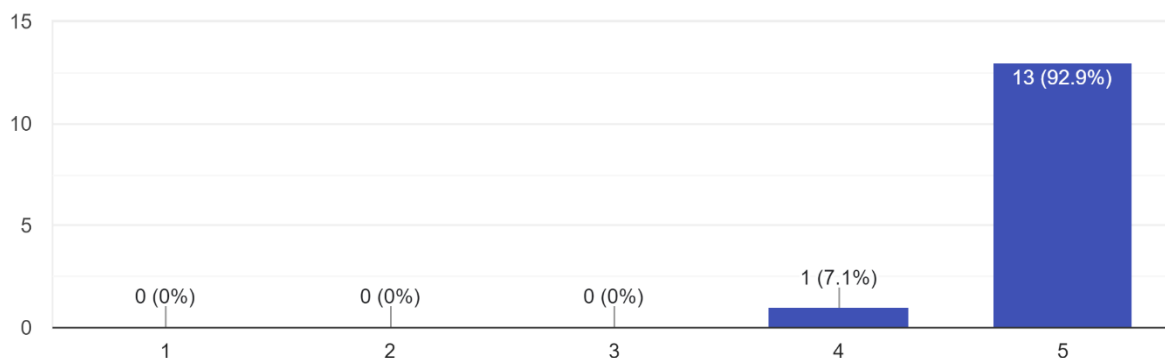

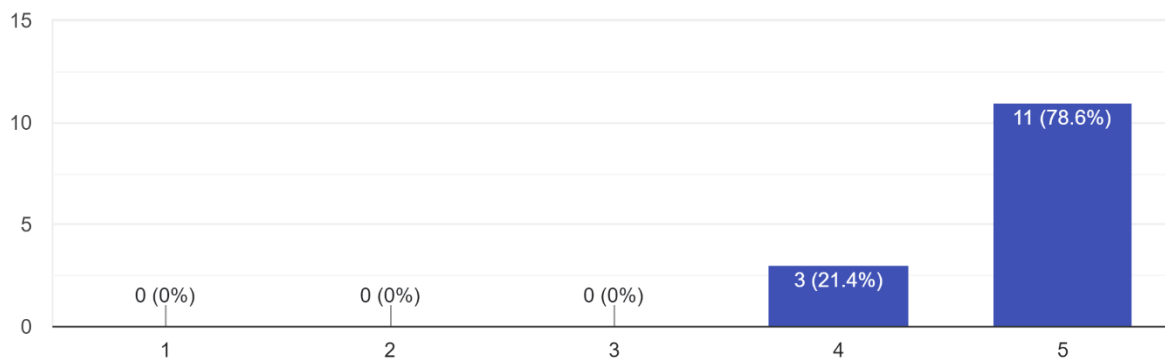
Evaluate the usefulness of the Flipped Classroom model in your daily classes (1 lowest score and 5 highest score)

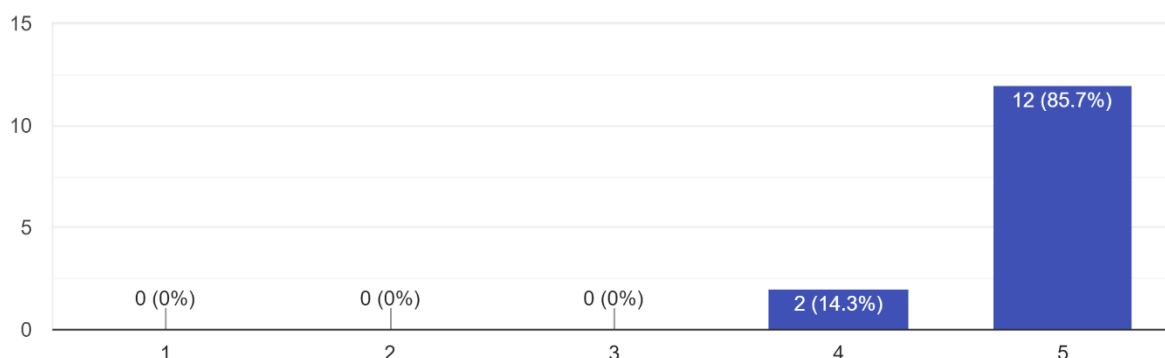






Have your academic results and/or interest improved after your participation in the mobility? (1 lowest score and 5 highest score)
