YELLOW symbolizes power, purity and the wealth of our country


BLUE is for the sky the most noble element which symbolises gentleness and faith Romania is one of the few countries that still use traditional costumes. We have a large variety of costumes.

### Danube Delta

- The Danube Delta Biosphere Reserve has the third largest biodiversity in the world (over 5,500 flora and fauna species), exceeded only by the Great Barrier Reef in Australia and the Galapagos Archipelago in Ecuador.
- The universal natural heritage value of the reserve was recognized in December 1990 by the inclusion of the strictly protected areas in the World Heritage List under the World Heritage Convention.
- Its size is almost 3446 Km



The Danube Delta contains more than 360 species of birds and 45 species of freshwater fish in its many lakes This is the place where millions of birds from different corners of the Earth (Europe, Asia, Africa, Mediterranean Sea) come to nest.





The Carpathians dominate the center of Romania, with 14 mountain ranges reaching above 2,000 m, and the highest Peak is Moldoveanu 2,544m.

The Carpathians lie on the territory of seven states: Czech Republic (3%), Slovakia (17%), Poland (10%), Hungary (4%), Ukraine (11%), Romania (51%) and The Republic of Serbia (4%).

#### **BALEA LAKE -** Glaciar Lake

Lake Balea is a glacier lake (formed in a glacier circus) located at an altitude of 2040 m in the Fagaras Mountains, Sibiu County.



### THE BLACK SEA



The Black Sea stretches over an area of 423,488 km<sup>2</sup>. The deepest point is 2211 m below sea level near Yalta.

#### THE PELES CASTLE



Peles Castle in Sinaia, was built between 1873 and 1914 to serve as the summer residence of the kings of Romania, the building is currently owned by the Royal Family of Romania and houses the Peles National Museum.

#### **BRAN CASTTLE**



Bran CASTTLE is a historical and architectural monument located in Bran-Rucar Pass, famous for count Dracula.

#### THE PALACE OF PARLIAMENT



The Palace of Parliament is the second largest administrative building for civilian use, and the most expensive administrative building in the world and the world's heaviest building. The Palace of Parliament building is located in the central part of Bucharest.

The building has approximately 1,000 rooms, including 440 offices, over 30 halls and salons, four restaurants, three libraries, two underground car parks, and a concert hall.




#### **ORADEA CITY - NEW MODERN CENTER**


