FALCONRY

LENT



- ◆ It's parade of masks around the village
- ◆ The origins of the celebrations that were to ensure a rich harvest, fertility and welcome to upcoming spring
- ◆ Lent was add to the UNESCO List at the end of 2010



KING'S RIDE

- ◆ This tradition hasn't known the origin yet
- ◆ In the Czech Republic, the King's ride exists only in a region called Slovácko
- ◆ Slovácko is the region in Morava near Slovakia
