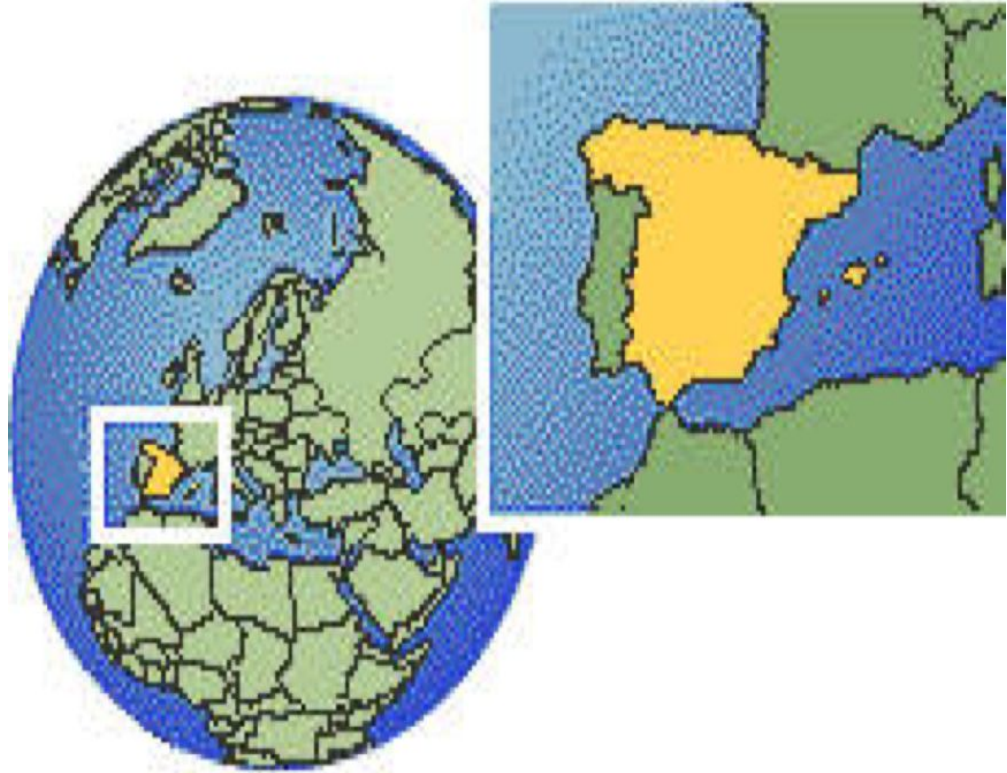

In Spain there are 17 autonomous regions and 2 territories with self-government (Ceuta and Melilla).

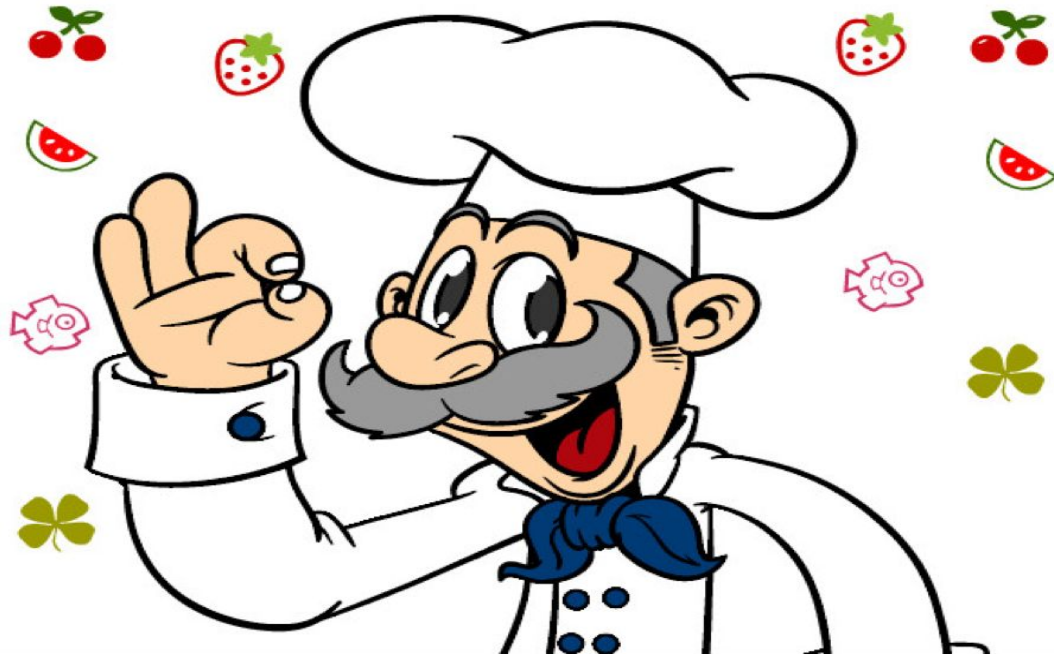


Three dialects are spoken in Spain:

Gazpacho

- Coming from Andalusia.
- Main ingredients: tomatoes, small green peppers, water, eggs, bread and salt.



Spanish omelette

- Coming from Extremadura.
- Main ingredients: potatoes, eggs, one tablespoon of olive oil and salt.



Migas:

- They come from Andalusia
- Main ingredients: bread slices, garlic, chorizo, sausages,...



Tapas

They are usually served in bars while you are having a soft-drink or a beer. They are like a kind of snack and they're easy to prepare.



TYPICAL DANCES:



Flamenco

Is an artform native to the Spanish regions of Andalusia, Extremadura and Murcia.

It includes singing, guitar playing, dance and handclapping. The genre originates in Andalusian music and dance styles.



Sevillian dance

Is a type of folk music and dance from Seville that in the 19th century they were influenced by Flamenco. This typical dance can be heard mainly in the famous Seville Fair. Sevillian dance are danced in pairs. .



Jota:

Is a genre of music and the associated dance known throughout Spain, most likely originating in Aragon. The jota is danced and sung accompanied by castanets, and the interpreters tend to wear regional costumes.

Enrique Iglesias is a Spanish singer, songwriter, actor and record producer.

María Lucía Sánchez Benítez, better known as **Malú** was born in Madrid.

In 1883 Antonio Gaudí took over the design of the Sagrada Familia.



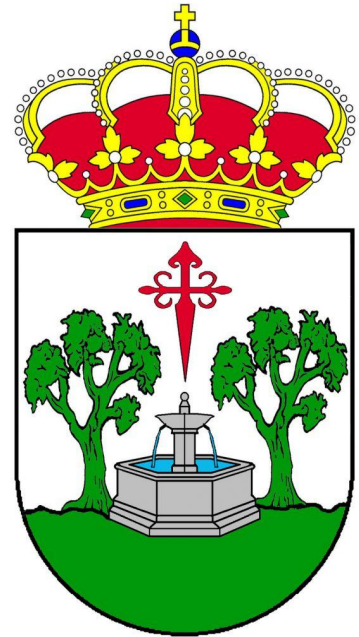
The Alhambra

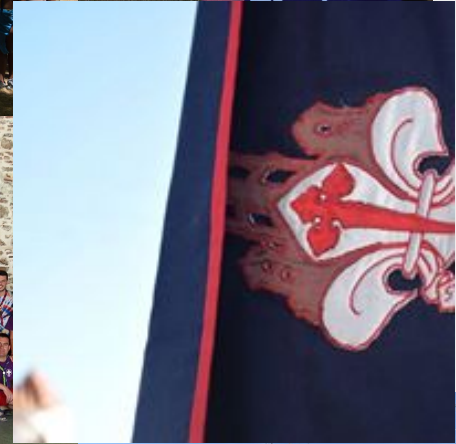

·GUADALCANAL IS LOCATED IN THE NORTH OF SEVILLE, IN THE NORTH OF ANDALUSIA

Some History:

ALTHOUGH THERE IS EVIDENCE OF HUMAN PRESENCE SINCE THE NEOLITHIC, ITS NAME DERIVED FROM THE ISLAMIC SETTLEMENT CALLED "WAD AL - KANAL" (THIS MEANS WATER CHANNEL) . IN 1241, GUADALCANAL WAS RECONQUERED BY THE KNIGHTS OF THE ORDER OF SANTIAGO, WHICH HAS LEFT IN THE ORAL TRADITIONS OF GUADALCANAL A POSTURE OF MEDIEVAL MYSTICISM.



CAPITANA MARATHON

CAPITANA MARATHON IS A TEST OF MOUNTAIN BIKES THAT IS CELEBRATED IN GUADALCANAL, WITHIN THE NATURAL PARK OF THE SIERRA NORTE DE SEVILLA, BUT ALSO RUNS THROUGH EXTREMADURAN LANDS (BADAJOS).

AT THE MOMENT IT'S COMPETITIVE IT HAS FORMED TWICE AS PART OF THE OPEN OF ANDALUSIAN MARATHON, WITH MORE THAN 800 RUNNERS FOR HAVING THE QUOTA SET IN THAT MARATHON. ALSO BELONGS TO THE PROVINCIAL CIRCUIT OF SEVILLE.

THIS YEAR HAS PAID HOMAGE TO A TEACHER FROM GUADALCANAL WHO DIED RUN OVER BY A CAR WHILE HE WAS RIDING THE BIKE PREPARING HIMSELF FOR THE MARATHON.

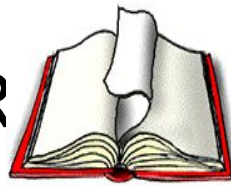
At IES de Llerena, there are eight hundred fifty-six students, ninety three teachers and a total of one hundred thirteen workers.

- We can say that in these eleven years we have been successful in having a much more ecological centre.

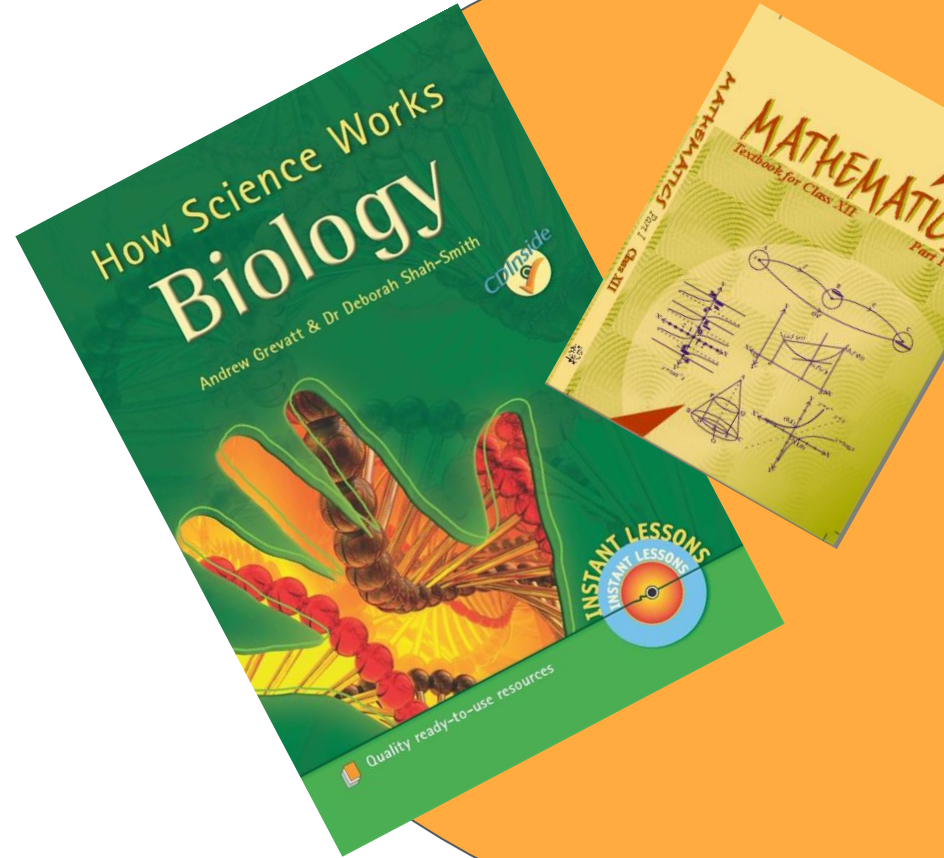


BILINGUAL SECTION
